In crisis settings, violence can thrive. This is largely compounded by gaps in accessing justice for people impacted by that violence.

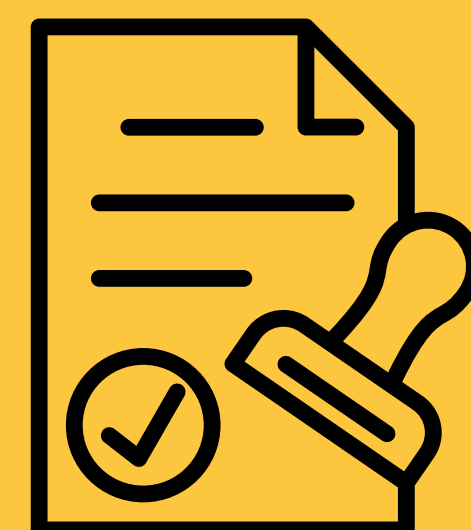
IRC SOLUTIONS improve A2J by:

350,890 individuals received legal information



31,935 individuals supported received civil documentation
