

### **Education is Rapidly Evolving**

- 40% of the largest K-12 school districts in the U.S. planned to start the 2020 school year in-person or in a hybrid education model.<sup>1</sup>
- A survey from a major school district in Pennsylvania concluded that 1/3 of the parents would opt for remote learning over in-class learning when school opened in the Fall.
- With distance learning becoming a more permanent fixture, collaborative learning approaches will become essential for all students.<sup>2</sup>
- Even pre-pandemic, Higher Education was growing online programs to scale and service an increasing non-traditional student population.<sup>3</sup>

## Remote Teaching Options Fall Short

- Asynchronous learning is a big step down – disengaging for both teacher and student.
- The virtual experience needs to closely match the physical experience without added complexity from technology tools.



# Solutions enabling real-time teacher student engagement

While teachers, students and parents are adapting to changes, expectations for an improved experience are stronger than ever. HP is enabling better learning solutions for real-time hybrid education from the classroom, without complicating teacher workflows.

- Teachers can schedule class periods for simple "one-touch join" to start classes with remote students using the intuitive interface in Microsoft Teams Rooms or Zoom Rooms.
- Remote students can join the scheduled class with Microsoft
  Teams or the Zoom app and then see and hear the teacher and
  instructional content, virtually raise their hand for questions and
  share their own content.
- In-room teachers and classmates can see, hear and engage with remote students in the meeting.
- Teachers can be seen anywhere in front of the classroom and easily share documents from a PC or content from the whiteboard. All with the push of a button.
- Classes can be recorded and include closed captioning for remote students. Transcriptions/closed captioning is available in recorded classes with on-demand playback.
- Teachers remain in control of the hybrid classroom. Able to start and stop class sessions; manage what in-room and remote students see and hear; and direct remote student participation.
