


Speaker Registration




Speaker Lounge

The Speaker Lounge is located in the foyer area outside the ICC Auditorium. You can find this closest to the Prince Regent entrance of the ExCeL Centre.

We would ask for you to report to the Speaker Lounge on the day of your session at least one hour before your scheduled session time to check in with the team, upload your presentation, check your slides and receive a final briefing from the Content Team.

Do I need to bring my laptop or device with me?	No - You do not need to bring a device but please ensure you share your PPT with us ahead of the show as requested.							
Can I use my own laptop or device for my PPT?	Yes – please bring an HDMI or mac adapter for your laptop or device with you							
Do you have a PPT Template	Yes – we'd be delighted to share a PPT template with you. You can find this on the Speaker Resources page.							
Do I have to use your PPT template?	No – but please ensure your presentation is in .ppt format (not .pdf) and in 16:9 widescreen format. Please remove any settings which automatically advance your presentation slides as there will be a clicker available. If you have any non-standard fonts in your presentation, please upload and label these fonts when you upload your presentation.							
How do I share my PPT with you?	We will provide a dropbox link prior to the show which will be open until 5pm GMT 27 March 2023. You can also bring your presentations to the Speaker Lounge onsite.

- <u>Live captioning</u> will take place in all theatres. Further information available upon request.
- We will be cleaning all lecterns, microphones and equipment in between each session to ensure our stages are <u>COVID-safe</u>.
- No <u>brochures, flyers and seat drops</u> can be given out post-session as per our ESG and COVID-safe policies. We would encourage the use of QR codes to direct the audience to additional resources.
- No <u>attendee data</u> will be shared with you unless previously agreed and arranged with the Bett Team. You can purchase a license to collect attendee data through our client engagement team.



Travel & Accommodation

• Speakers are required to book and plan their own travel and accommodation for Bett. We have negotiated for special discounted rates for attendees at a wide range of hotels across London for you to take advantage of.

Directions to the ExCeL Centre

By train: DLR services: Custom House and Prince Regent. Elizabeth Line services: Prince Regent. This year, we are now based in the East wing of ExCeL London and the closest stop to Bett is the Prince Regent station. ExCeL is approximately 20-minutes walking distance away from Canning Town underground station. The DLR and Jubilee Line can be connected from multiple Overground lines such as Stratford, Canada Water, and Shadwell. It's also possible to join the Overground and travel to ExCeL London from Euston station.

By car: Parking is available on a first come, first served basis, using pay and display. If you are travelling to ExCeL London by road please use postcode E16 1XL to find us.

By plane: London City, Gatwick and Heathrow Airport are the nearest airports to the venue.
