Scholarships

The Goethe-Institut in the UK awards scholarships every year to attend **language courses or training seminars** (e.g. regional studies, German as a foreign language methodology/didactics) **in Germany**. You can apply for a scholarship from the Goethe-Institut if you are a teacher of German as a foreign language or if you train German teachers.



Deutsch Lehren Lernen (DLL)

The **professional development programme** DLL serves the practical qualification of German teachers—be it in primary, secondary or adult education. Topics such as skills training, teaching grammar and vocabulary, phonetics, literature, social forms, etc. are integrated into this competence- and practice-oriented online course.



Upskilling courses

These courses can be offered at your school or online. The sessions enable teachers to deliver German language lessons with the Goethe-Institut's Felix & Franzi Key Stage 2 materials in an age-appropriate, knowledgeable, informed, varied, confident and enthusiastic way.

Young Goethe Scheme

Our *Young Goethe Scheme* offers primary and secondary teachers in the UK the opportunity to **invite Young Goethe Ambassadors into their classrooms** to motivate younger students to learn (or continue to learn) German.



Digital Kinderuniversität

This platform gives young scientists the chance to find out the answers to questions for themselves—about natural phenomena, for instance—while at the same time learning their first words in German. This **fun online learning** environment reflects the basic structure of a university and the carefully selected video sequences reflect the world as experienced by young students.

Our regular competitions offer a great opportunity for young learners to **actively use the German language** and promote their creativity.

Workshops

We can offer workshops both in primary schools and online on motivating topics to facilitate an **authentic contact with the German language and culture** among children and to inspire them to learn German.

Advertising Kits

The Language Magician

This computer-based game is a fun way for pupils to build on their language and IT-skills while providing you as the teacher with information on their progression in foreign language learning. It can be used as an **assessment tool** to test the pupils' language skills without them noticing that they are being assessed and, at the same time, entertaining them and letting them have fun in learning a foreign language.

Teacher Materials

The Goethe-Institut offers **free materials for teaching German in primary schools**. The hand puppets Felix and Franzi playfully teach children about the German language and culture. For the upper primary level, we offer materials with the animated film characters Karla and Kai. We are continuously developing primary teaching materials on current topics like health, music and the environment. Our dossiers provide background information, professional development trainings, and educational programmes for students.



Learn German with songs

The two songbooks with accompanying CDs for children aged 5-11 provide a wealth of possibilities for use in German lessons for key stages 1 and 2, and have been written by Martina Schwarz and published by the Goethe-Institut London. The **books and CDs feature 27 songs (with karaoke versions)** with notated melody lines, guitar chords, lyrics and motivational worksheets with teaching methods.
