

Wood and plastic

All of Melcourt's eligible bark and wood-based ingredients hold Forest Stewardship Council certification. The Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) is an international network that promotes the responsible management of the world's forests.

We are constantly looking for ways to reduce our use of plastic. At present there isn't a material that can fully replace it as our products are frequently damp, heavy and stored outside


However, our polythene bags currently contain 30% recycled plastic and we are working with our supplier to raise this to 50% by 2025.

Our bags are also fully recyclable. The award-winning Melcourt Bag for Life scheme (see page 17) allows participating garden centres to offer a reusable bag system which is very popular with consumers.







Product for the refillable **Bag For Life** bags comes in a Maxi Bale. Each Maxi Bale contains 2500 litres, is spun-wrapped, labelled, and delivered on a recycled and recyclable one-way-trip pallet.

Buy a pack of 55 Bag For Life bags that you can sell to your customer to fill repeatedly with compost or mulch from the Maxi Bales. On their third refill, customers would be in plastic 'credit' – a contribution in kind to the environment.



Stockist Information

Getting the best from Melcourt stock

We constantly analyse customer feed-back and are always seeking practical ways to improve our offer. The most frequently raised issues by consumers hinge around product storage and stock rotation.

Product Storage

- All of our polythene packed retail products are carefully machine packed and hooded for weather protection.
- At the garden centre or retail outlet, these products, particularly composts, topsoil and soil improvers, should be stored in dry, under covered areas.

Stock Rotation

- During manufacture, each bag is clearly laser printed with the date of manufacture.
- During the season, please take care to ensure that the oldest stock is sold first.
- It is not good practice to hold stock that is over one year old.
- At the end of the season, we recommend that you clear any remaining stock, leaving just enough stock to service the quieter winter months.
- Re-order fresh stock late winter for following season's sales.

THE MANUFACTURER

Should provide simple and clear information to both stockists and consumers, covering: product use; product management; and use by date. Melcourt also provide support both in the field and on our helpline.

Melcourt have invested in state of the art laser printer so that date of manufacture is clearly printed.



We do not make large quantities of compost during the 'low season', for sale next year, but usually make our compost products within four weeks of despatch.

In the rare occurrence of a customer complaint, we respond promptly and courteously usually to the complainant's entire satisfaction.

FOR THE RETAILER

All Melcourt peat-free composts are 'active' and should be sold and used in accordance with the instructions which are clearly printed on each pack.



The issue of stock rotation is extremely important. Melcourt field sales staff will explain to our stockists why and what simple steps should be taken to help.

We recommend that at the end of each season, all old stock is sold, leaving space for new, fresh stock to be bought in next season.

Unfortunately, we do not offer a sale or return service, therefore it is clearly for the stockist to ensure that the oldest stock is sold first.

FOR THE CUSTOMER

Carefully follow the instructions that are printed on the back of the bag regarding use by advice.

If you need further help, contact Melcourt.

Any surplus compost that is not used within the recommended period can be spread onto the garden as an effective soil improver.



The polythene bag containing the product is strong enough to be re-used many times around the home and garden. For example, as a hanging basket liner, as a sturdy container for canes or for taking green waste to the tip.

Frequently asked questions.

What is peat-free compost?

Peat-free compost is simply a growing medium manufactured without the inclusion of peat. Peat has been the staple ingredient in UK growing media for many decades but since the late 1980s environmental concerns have created the need to look for alternatives.

Why the change to peat-free?

It is now widely recognised both in the UK and internationally that the harvesting of peat releases vast quantities of carbon dioxide into the atmosphere. In addition, left in situ it is also host to a unique flora and fauna as well as having an important role in flood mitigation.

When will peat be banned in the UK?

The UK government is proposing to ban the use of peat in retail products from 2024. They plan to follow this up with a ban on the use of peat in professional growing by 2026 (with a few exceptions).

Are they made to a British Standard specification?

There is no British Standard for growing media but the Responsible Sourcing of Growing Media (see below) includes a performance standard. At Melcourt we carry out our own rigorous testing at our two regional trials sites in order to ensure that our composts are consistently achieving the required high standard of performance.

Are all peat-free composts the same?

Very definitely not! Melcourt have been at the forefront of peat-free development having launched their first professional peat-free compost Sylvamix, in 2001. Widely acknowledged to be the market leader, SylvaGrow was brought to the retail market in 2014 and since then the range has won many performance awards, become endorsed by the RHS and gained two Royal Warrants.

Do peat-free composts need different management to peat-based products?

Peat-free composts vary in their ingredients and so the management required for them to best perform also varies. However, at Melcourt we realised that it isn't practical to expect gardeners of different degrees of experience to be able necessarily to judge how to manage their composts. So we designed our SylvaGrow range to be easy to use and its management is very similar to traditional peat-based media. However, in common with many peat-free media it can look dry on the surface when in fact it is perfectly adequately watered underneath. We recommend checking this using the weight of the pot or by the 'finger test' – simply pushing a finger into the layers below the surface in order to check the moisture content.

What does 'organic' mean?

The word 'organic' is one of the most misused words in retail horticulture. Often confusingly used to merely indicate the presence of organic matter in a mix, a truly organic product is one that is approved by a recognised organic certification body following a strict audit process. It will contain only materials that are free from artificial fertilizers and pesticides. SylvaGrow Organic and the Planter for Organic Growing are approved by the Soil Association which is the nation's most well-known organic certification body.

What is the 'Responsible Sourcing Scheme'?

The Responsible Sourcing of Growing Media Scheme allows stockists and consumers a much greater level of transparency about the ingredients used in composts and their impacts on the environment. Created by a cross-industry group that included conservation bodies, manufacturers, retailers, growers, the HTA and the RHS, the newly-launched scheme brings evidence and clarity to an area that has previously been clouded by misinformation and conjecture. What is John Innes?

John Innes compost is a soil-based medium based on a formula created at the John Innes Institute in the 1930s. The SylvaGrow John Innes range is peat-free. See our website for a full description including the history of this heritage range.
