What you'll find when browsing my collections is influence from being outside so workwear, streetwear, technical wear with fabrics to match each piece from heavier cottons, cotton twill, nylons for added depth and shine also every drop will always have a smart/casual knitwear section to create a traditional/old school 50's feel.

Being someone whose worked the majority of my life outside and never being satisfied or finding peace in what I was doing, it was only right to take myself away to travel the world and gain a knowledge of life based on sights, smells and sounds I experience. As a result I have gained great inspiration of the actual places I travel to

For this Autumn/Winter drop I've taken a lot of inspiration from an industrial and workwear influence. You'll see some heavy canvas, sherpa, insulated shirts and corduroy pants to keep you warm through the colder months, some beautiful roll neck waffle long sleeve's perfect for layering. And also some nylon to give off that tech wear feel

The stand out colour for this seasons drop is Orange to keep that industrial approach I was going for.

To make it simple everything is available in sizes S, M, L, XL, XXL.

Tees have a heavier cotton feel and an oversized/boxy look to give it a 90s aesthetic. Casual insulated shirts have a regular fit.

Pants and cordurous have a straight fit or wide taper for ease of movement and comfort.


The knitwear in this seasons rotation is some lovely button up cardigans to keep that classic look. But also some zip front cardigans for a more casual and up to date look






