Being a life long crafter and keen to be as sustainable as possible, founder of Stitch Happy, Louisa, realised that eco-friendly craft supplies were hard to find. Most brands she found had a very small range of eco-friendly fabrics and materials, and as a busy mum of two, having to scour the internet for eco-friendly options was time consuming and frustrating. Louisa took the matter into her own hands and started Stitch Happy to sell ethical and sustainable craft supplies for modern makers who shared this desire for a more sustainable product.

Louisa started by teaching crafts to people in her local area and selling ethical kits and products online. Then the pandemic hit and Louisa realised that she would not be able to deliver workshops, but that people really wanted things to do to keep them occupied. The kits that she had always sold as a sideline became her primary focus. Louisa realised that this was the way to make a real difference. By selling kits and patterns she could reach a wider audience and give more people the option to choose sustainability.

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By bundling everything they needed into a kit she could help busy people, who didn't have time to research and source all the elemnts needed, to create something beautiful.

Fast forward to today, and the kits are now front and centre of the business. Having proved very popular during lockdown people are continuing with these new hobbies and habits. This continuing rise in popularity of crafting has taken Stitch Happy from a one-woman kitchen table business, to a successful small business offering wholesale to a host of ethically-minded large and small businesses, as well as our direct customers. All of our kits are still made in our rural studio in the UK ensuring that we can keep quality high and labour practices ethical.
