

Look at designer such as Paul & Joe, MSGM and Richard Quinn.


















Design for digital still remains a key trend for Spring Summer 22.


Digital waves and psychedelic prints become sophisticated appealing to a wider audience. Use Monochrome patterns like Brandon Maxwell for commercial look.



Soft Focus

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
