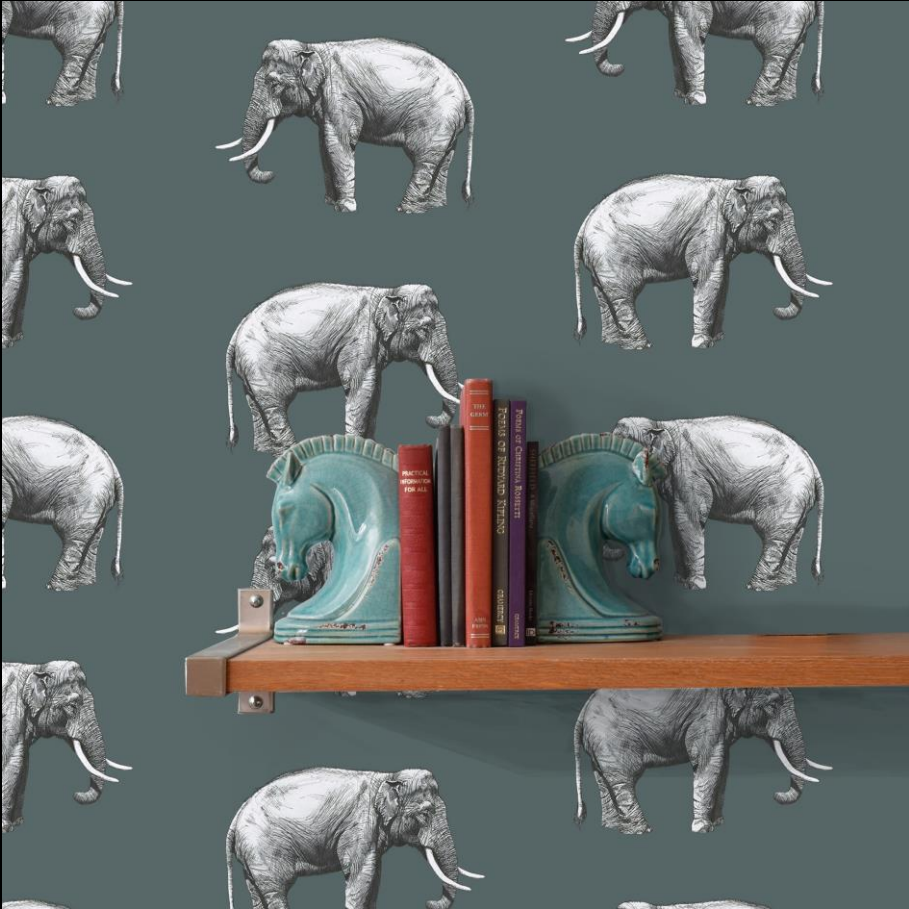

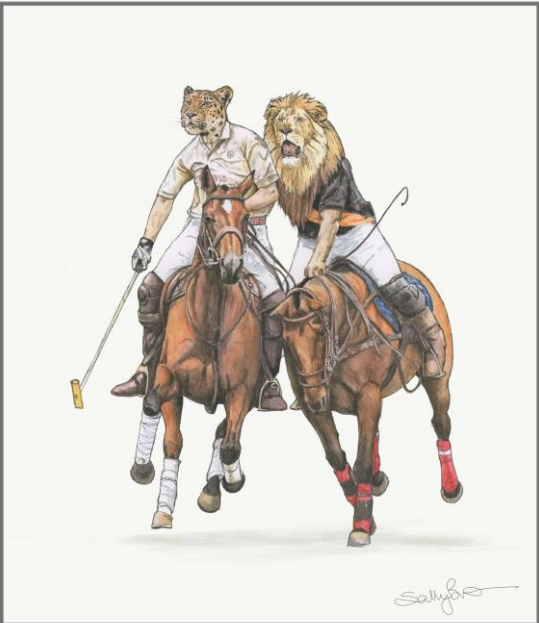
Polo, known as The Sport of Kings, this illustration shows Kings of the Jungle playing polo.

The Sport of Kings

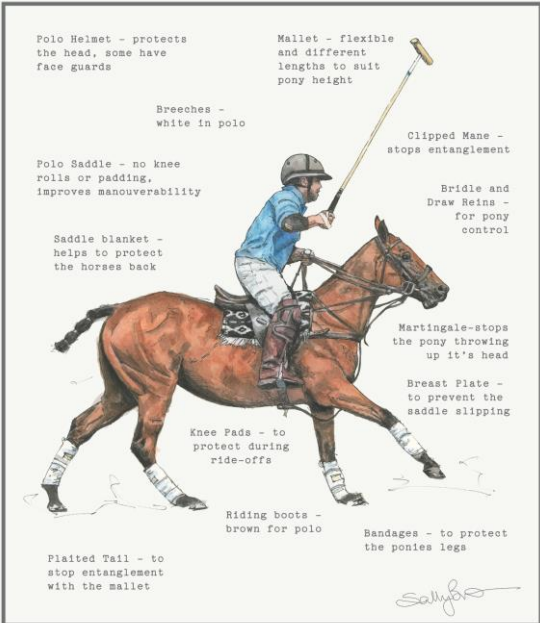


Polo is the oldest ball sport in the world. Dating back to 600 AD in Persia, it was originally a training game for cavalry. The game is divided into chukkas which are seven minutes long. Two teams of four horse riders oppose one another, attempting to score the most goals.

The sport spread to India, and in the 1850's British Cavalry drew

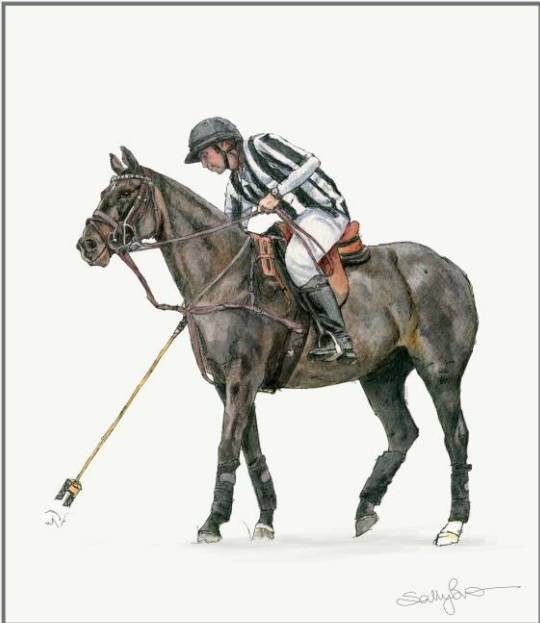
up the first modern day rules.

Polo Equipment



Other than the mallet and the ball, polo equipment is used to ensure the safety of the player and the polo pony. A polo pony needs to be fast, brave, agile and intelligent. Various horse breeds make good polo ponies, not too big so they can stop and turn quickly. Thoroughbreds, quarter horses and thoroughbred crosses are popular.

The Polo Umpire



The game of polo begins when the umpire throws the ball into play. The umpire keeps order in the game, making sure it runs smoothly and safeguarding the ponies and players. In this high adrenaline sport, things can become heated. The umpire can give yellow and red cards if needed.
