



Accessibility



Quiet Space

Bett has a dedicated Quiet Space in London Room 5 for those seeking sanctuary from the large crowds away from the show floor. It can be located on maps or by asking a member of staff. We encourage anyone to use this facility as much as they need.

Accessible entrances

There are two stations at either entrance to the EXCeL (Prince Regent and Custom House) both have stepfree access. Bett will be promoting the Prince Regent as the primary entry to the ExCeL due to its location to the exhibition. Entry from the Custom house station will require a walk of approximately 600 metres to the Exhibition Hall. The Prince Reagent DLR Station is a significantly shorter distance to the Exhibition Hall.

The entrances and exits to and from the ExCeL are wheelchair accessible via low gradient ramps and automatic doors.



Food and Drinks

There are many outlets offering a variety of food and beverages options throughout the boulevard at the ExCeL. Whether it be takeaway or sitdown table service. Most will accommodate the use of any specialist cutlery or beverage vessels.

Make It Fun

- Scavenger Hunt: Create a list of things for children to spot at the show (e.g a robot, a 3D printer, or a VR demo).
- □ **Reflection Time:** At the end of each day, ask children to share their favourite moment or something new they learned.
- □ **Take Photos:** Capture group photos and videos at iconic spots and let children take their own pictures (with supervision).
- Encourage Questions: Motivate children to engage with exhibitors and ask about the technology on display. Get curious
