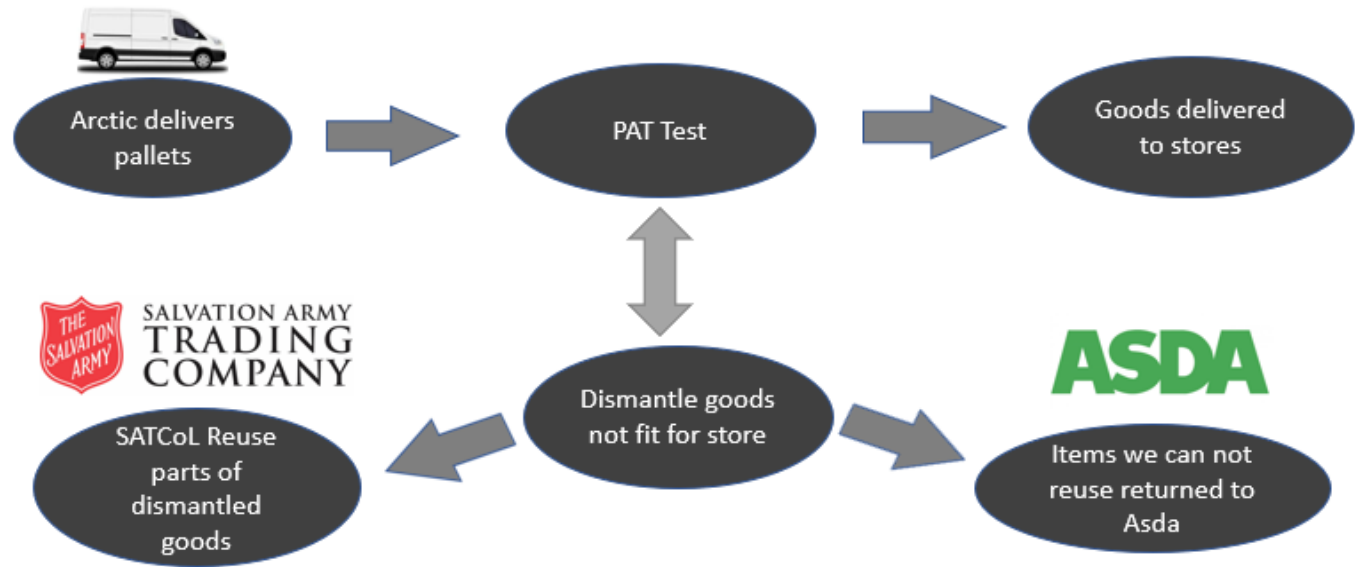
## About Us

- **SATCoL is the trading arm of The Salvation Army. We are the largest charity owned textiles collector in the U.K actively working to support organisations reduce their carbon footprint and combat climate change.**
- **Through our various reuse and recycling schemes, we lessen the impact on overflowing landfill sites by extending the useful life of products with a minimising waste approach.**

# How to donate

- It's simple, we are keen to receive returned or faulty stock. Our drivers will collect the boxed donations and deliver them to our 25,000 sq ft warehouse, where we can accept over 1000 Euro size pallets.
- We provide a hub for you to donate stock that can be reused, repurposed or recycled.
- Our Processing Centre staff are fully trained to P.A.T test all goods and will organize the products into categories for distribution.
- It's the modern approach to corporate charitable donations and an efficient way to combat climate change.
- Once tested, products suitable for resale will be distributed to our 240 retail outlets and items that can not be resold will be dismantled and the parts reused or returned to Asda to be recycled.
- The profits raised from these charitable donations will be donated to The Salvation Army to continue to support the great work they do.

# Why Choose Us?

- Our corporate donations process is the perfect way to support the circular economy. It's fast, efficient and an easy way to actively work towards the environmental change ASDA would like to see.
- We prevent 235,000 tonnes of greenhouse gases from entering the atmosphere each year - this is the equivalent of the emissions generated, on average, from 120,000 cars in 12 months.
- We also collect around 50,000 tonnes of textiles each year and thanks to the generosity of members of the public we are able to reuse, repurpose and recycle these donations too.
