

AFFORESTATION

Over 35 acres of our land is dedicated for tree plantation. We currently have 5000 Neem trees (Nimtree or Indian Lilac), from the Mahogany family. All parts of the Neem tree are believed to be of immense medicinal benefit to humans. Neem is also an effective natural pesticide. In addition, we currently have about 2000 trees meant as fodder for cows, that lead to an enhancement of milk yield. These trees include River Tamarind, East India Walnut, Indian Blackwood and Ringworm Bush. Our aim is to nurture these trees and to resort to reforestation as and when required.



We intend to plant an additional 2,000 trees by 2026.



Our aim is to have a total of 70% women in our workforce, by 2026.
