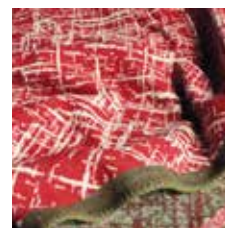

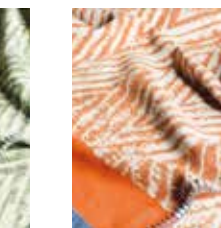

RECYCLED COTTON

FROM FABRIC WASTE, TO FIBRE, TO THROW A 5-STEP JOURNEY

TEXTILE COLLECTION

The journey begins by collecting post-production cotton waste, such as surplus fabric from garment manufacturing or offcuts from the pattern-making process. Instead of wasting this valuable material, it's given new purpose and meaning.

SORTING & PREPARATION

Recycling experts carefully sort through the collected garments, removing non-cotton elements like zips or buttons, and arranging them by colour. These fabric pieces are then prepared for the transformation process.

BREAKING DOWN THE FIBRES

The prepared garments undergo a state-of-the-art process to break down the cotton fibres into their raw form. This step is crucial to create pristine, high-quality recycled cotton.

SPINNING INTO NEW YARN

Once the fibres are transformed, they're spun into new yarns, ready to weave the story of your next cosy blanket. Each yarn carries the tales of the recycled textile it originated from – a tale of sustainability and style.

BLANKET CRAFTING

Our skilled artisans weave the new yarns into our sumptuous blankets, ensuring the perfect blend of comfort and conscience. The outcome? A stunning, eco-friendly masterpiece, tailored just for you!

DID YOU KNOW...

No additional dyes are used in these yarns; they simply inherit the colour from the recycled fabric.

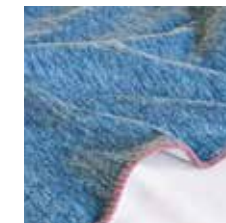

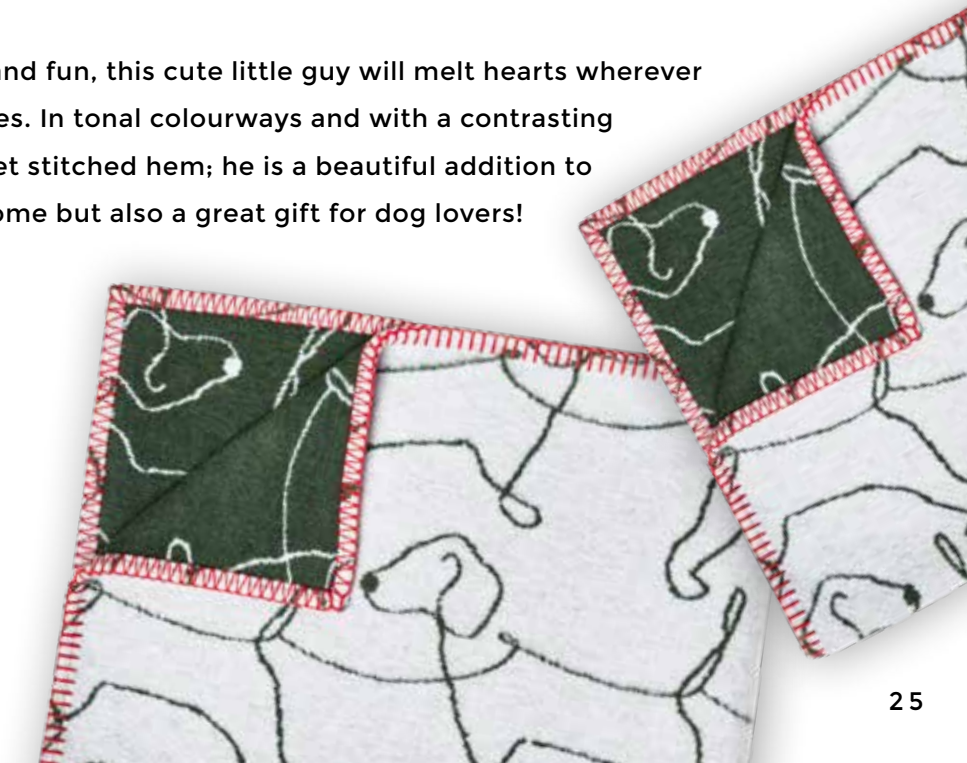

CARING FOR YOUR BLANKET

According to Wrap UK, extending the life of clothing and textiles by just nine months could reduce the UK's carbon, water and waste footprints by around 20-30%.

To ensure that you get the best out of your throw, follow the care instructions to ensure this blanket lasts you for years to come, doing your bit for the planet... One snuggle at a time!

INSTRUCTIONS

Our blankets can be washed at 30°C, in a domestic washing machine. They should be line dried, but once they are fully dried you can place these in a tumble dryer (on a cold setting) to fluff the fibres back up.
