



Daily health screenings will be conducted before you enter the event.

Anyone with an elevated temperature or fever will not be allowed into ATD21 HQ unless cleared by a medical professional. Medical services will be available on-site.



Masks will be required for attendees and staff.

We will provide PPE kits for attendees that will contain disposable masks, hand sanitizer, and wipes.



There will be reduced registration lines.

Digital badges will be sent via email and should be printed at home to reduce lines onsite. Satellite registration sites (located at select conference hotels) will have lanyards and badge holders available for attendees for convenient pick up.





Hand sanitizer stations will be available throughout the event.

Touchless hand sanitizer stations will be plentiful throughout the conference.



Electrostatic sprayers will be used to clean session rooms and the EXPO.

All session rooms will be disinfected after each session, and the EXPO will close midday for cleaning.



There will be larger aisles in the EXPO to help manage traffic.

To keep attendees from being crowded on the EXPO floor, aisles have been increased to be 20 feet wide. Social distancing markers for attendees to follow will be placed throughout the floor.



Education sessions will be set up to allow six feet of space between chairs.

All sessions are planned to accommodate social distancing requirements at a limited capacity. Sessions will require advanced signup for attendees to secure their seats, and attendance will be verified at the door.



General sessions will have limited occupancy and will be set up to allow for six feet of space between chairs.

General sessions will be streamed to overflow rooms as well as live on the virtual platform. Explore our VIP addon option to guarantee a seat in the general session room.
