COVID-19 Reminders

ATD is committed to providing you with a comfortable learning environment. Our [COVID precautions](#) can be reviewed on our site.

Following revised CDC guidance, everyone participating on-site at ATD21 HQ this year are required to wear a mask or face covering while indoors. Attendees will receive PPE kits in their conference bags during the check-in process. The kits will include disposable masks and other personal sanitizer products.

Print Badges at Home

We will have a new registration experience this year. You will be able to print your badge at home and collect a badge holder and lanyard at any of the conference hotels. This will eliminate any need to visit registration onsite. Badges print on standard size paper which can then be trimmed or folded to fit in the badge holder and can utilize any computer printer. You will receive an "Express Registration" email on August 25.

We highly recommend printing in advance so you can skip any potential line onsite. Should you forget, Print My Badge stations will be conveniently located near the convention center entrances or you can visit full-service registration in the South Lobby starting Friday, August 27.

Silent Disco Anyone?

To deliver our super sessions and EXPO theater presentations, we will be utilizing RF headsets. These headsets will be available onsite and allow you to tune in to the speaker and stage presentation – sound is not amplified. While these devices come with headsets, you may have a favorite set of headphones you'd prefer to use. Any headset with a 3.5mm jack can be used. The radio listening devices are not Bluetooth capable.

Mobile Application & Charging Stations

Our conference platform, Pathable, is available on your mobile device or tablet. Download the **ATD Conferences & Events App** from your app store and log-in to sync your account and access all your agenda, session details, exhibitor listings and more. You'll need your mobile device a LOT onsite, so **we highly recommend a portable charger** just in case your phone needs a little life support during the day. We will also have charging stations available in the Global Village and Upper Concourse.

Travel Details – Airport Transportation

Transportation from airports is not provided for attendees but there are several options available. We recommend utilizing the TRAX light rail system from the airport which is only \$2.50 to get downtown. Alternatively, Uber, Lyft and taxi service are available and cost approximately \$15-20 each way.
