Print Badges at Home

Start your conference experience without a line when you print your badge at home and collect a badge holder and lanyard at any of the conference hotels or convention center. This will eliminate any need to visit registration on-site. You will receive an Express Registration email from donotreply@compusystems.com on August 25. Badges use any computer printer and print on standard size paper, which can then be trimmed or folded to fit in the badge holder.

We highly recommend printing in advance so you can skip any potential line on-site. Should you forget, Print My Badge stations will be conveniently located near the convention center entrances or you can visit full-service registration in the South Lobby starting Friday, August 27.

Packing List
