Access the Conference Mobile App
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All registered ATD TK 2023 attendees were sent an invite to log in to the ATD Conferences & Events app; this invite was directed to the email address provided during the registration process.

Open the **ATD Conferences & Events** app on your device. Select ATD 2023 TechKnowledge from the list of events. Once it opens, select **Sign in** and then the **Forgot Password** option, and enter the email address you used for registration to reset your account information. Once you've reset your account, please select **Login** and enter your information.

 If you registered on site, search for "ATD Conferences & Events" in your app store. Install the ATD Conferences & Events app and select the **ATD 2023 TechKnowledge** icon to download the information for TK 2023. Select **Create Account** and follow the instructions to set up your account.

Attendee Badge Scanning for ATD Events

Your name badge is printed with a QR code that contains the contact and demographic information you provided when you registered for ATD TK 2023. Sponsors ("Company") may request permission to scan your badge to add your information to their contact database.

By agreeing to have your badge scanned by the company, you are consenting to allow it to communicate with you directly. All such communication is governed by the privacy policies of the company performing the scan. Once your badge is scanned, it is your responsibility to manage your communication preferences directly with that company.

Certificate of Attendance and Transcript for Continuing Education

ATD TK 2023 is CE eligible with the ATD Certification Institute, HRCI and SHRM. You must complete an evaluation for each session you attended in-person or watched

virtually or on-demand to receive credit for the session on your ATD TK CE transcript. Starting **February 13, 2023** you can download your transcript and certificate of attendance for use in self-report earned continuing education credits (CEs) for certification or re-certification with each credentialing body using the same link as the survey evaluations. Session evaluations can be accessed through the ATD TK 2023 mobile app. You will also receive a separate email from speakers@td.org to access session evaluations online. Please log in using your email address as your username and your last name as your password to complete an evaluation for each session you attended. The session evaluation will close on **April 14, 2023**. After the 14th, you will only be able to print a copy of your certificate of attendance. You will not be able to add additional sessions to your transcript.
