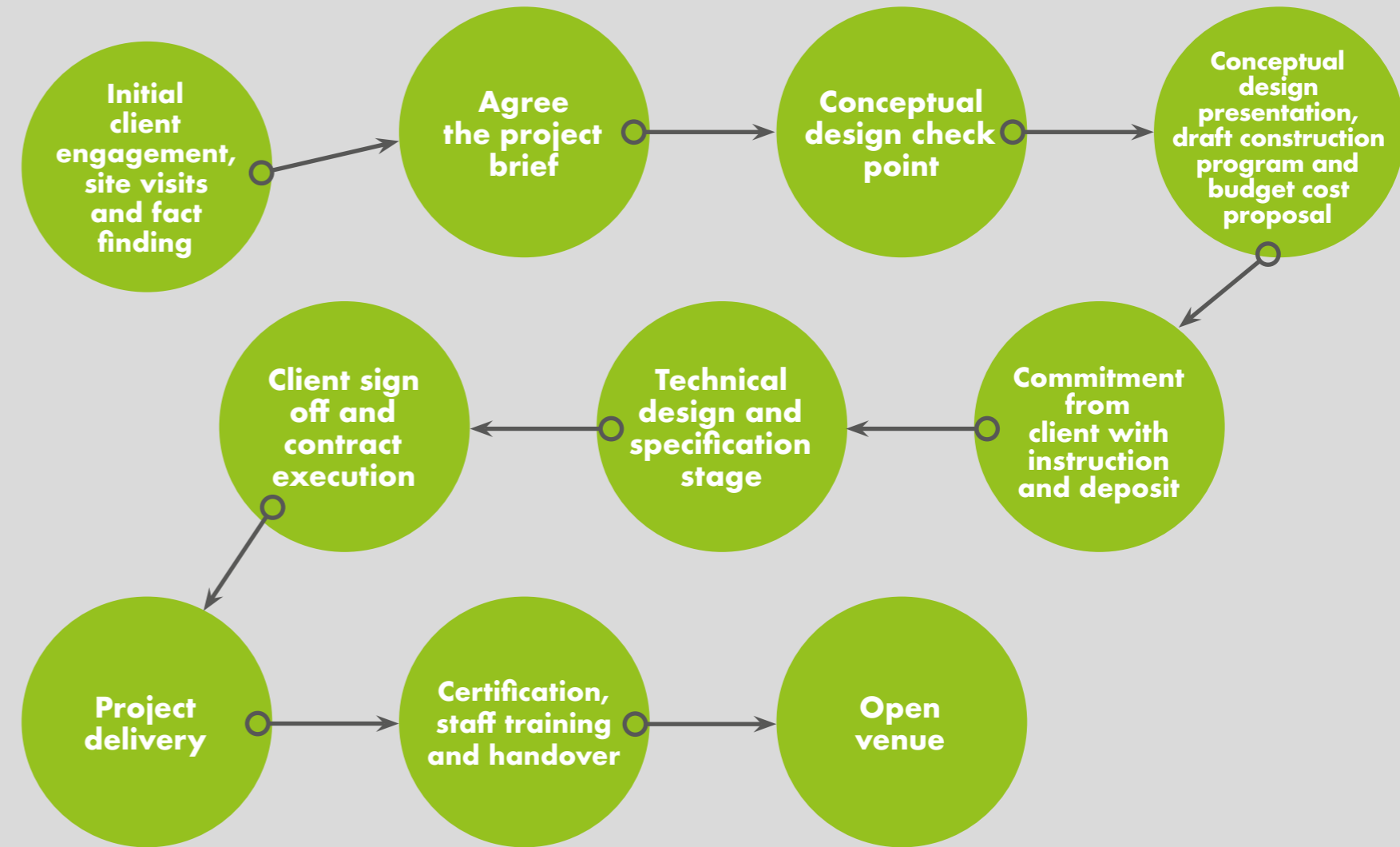

We build to European Standards - EN 11567 and Universal ACCT standards to mitigate risk.

The safety systems we use are category E, which means they cannot come unattached, unless a tool is used. This provides the highest level of safety available.

We provide:

- Training prior to opening, allowing for the opportunity of a designated technical advisor for ongoing health and safety support
- We subject all our installations to an independent inaugural inspection to ensure all standards are met



High ropes courses are a great way to encourage families to enjoy an epic adventure...and can be constructed around another attraction easily, such as adventure golf!



Here are some of the key benefits of creating a High Ropes course for your venue:

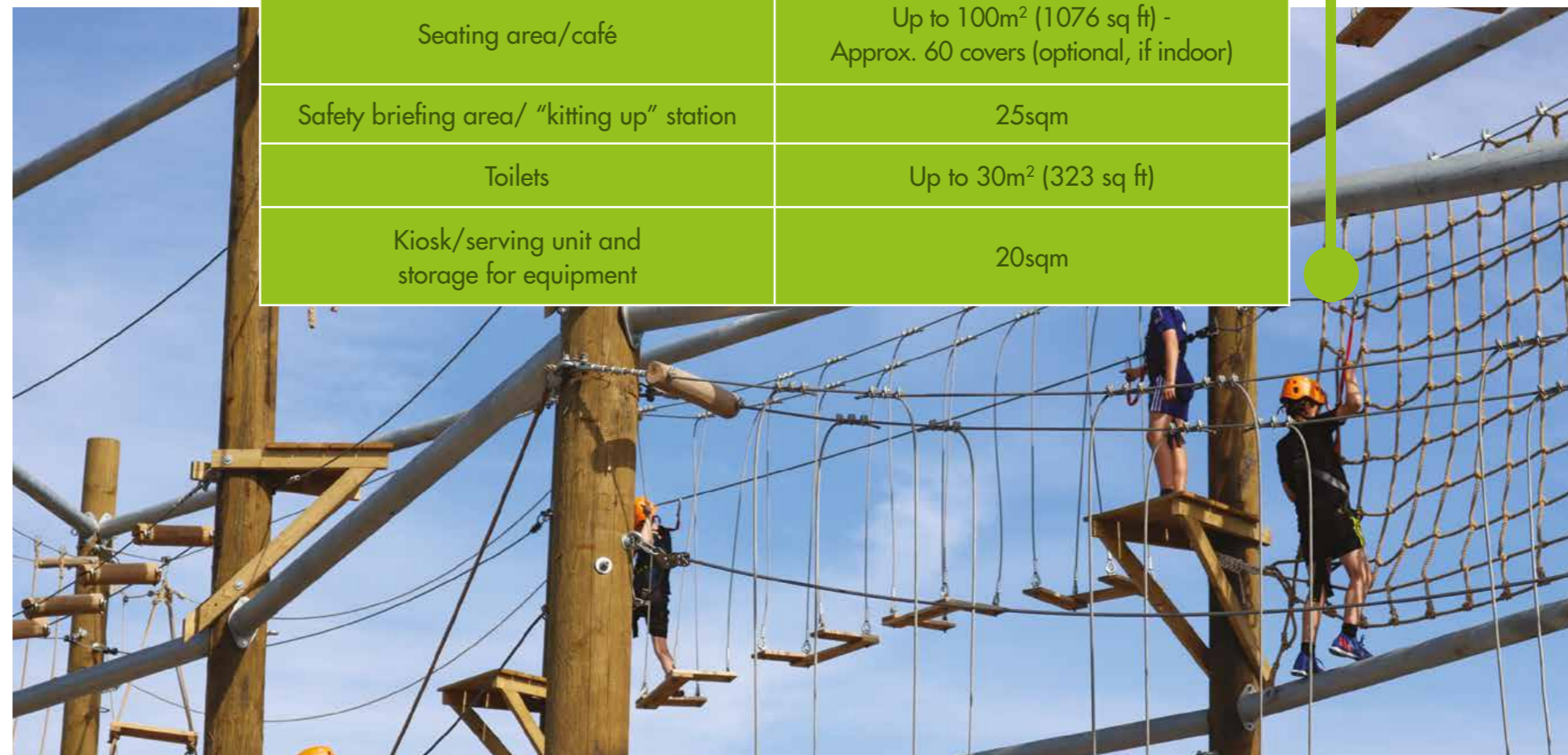
- Creates a fantastic visual attraction, drawing visitors in from afar
- Amazing social media opportunities
- Can be created in tandem with a new or existing attraction, resulting in higher yield per person
- Courses can be tailored to target market – can vary in levels of difficulty

High ropes exterior courses can be designed around the contours of the land. Where each brief is individual and different, we can incline or decline the challenge elements to suit as required.

When considering a new high ropes course, here are a few key requirements we would usually suggest:

Challenges	12-15 challenges recommended or one course
Seating area/café	Up to 100m ² (1076 sq ft) - Approx. 60 covers (optional, if indoor)
Safety briefing area/ "kitting up" station	25sqm
Toilets	Up to 30m ² (323 sq ft)
Kiosk/serving unit and storage for equipment	20sqm



Climbing walls are aesthetically pleasing and provide plenty of opportunity to combine challenges with fun and fitness!



Some of the key benefits include:

- An adrenaline pumping activity which encourages customers to return
- High customer satisfaction rate. As well as learning how to climb, you also acquire an additional skill in using the climbing equipment
- Users find it an addictive activity and therefore encourages customers to return to your venue and also bring friends along!
- Very beneficial for fitness as climbing provides a full body workout – which can be designed to suit multiple demographics (including easier courses for younger ages, or more intricate courses for seasoned climbers)
- Climbing can be suitable for all venues – you don't necessarily need a tall space! Bouldering is also a very popular form of climbing which only needs a small enclosed space
- Climbing is suitable for both indoor and outdoor locations, so there are multiple opportunities



Here are a few key space requirements we would usually suggest:

Kiosk/serving unit and storage for equipment	20sqm

Zip Coasters are wildly popular – and not just as an outdoor attraction! They can be built indoors, subject to height restrictions, and serve as a fun-filled activity for visitors of all ages.

Zip Wires are fantastic attractions for a more high octane, adrenaline-fuelled adventure. They have become increasingly popular as visitors seek more unique experiences... and there are so many possibilities with the style, theming and duration – it's just choosing that can be the tricky part!



Here are some of the key benefits of creating a Zip Wire attraction for your venue:

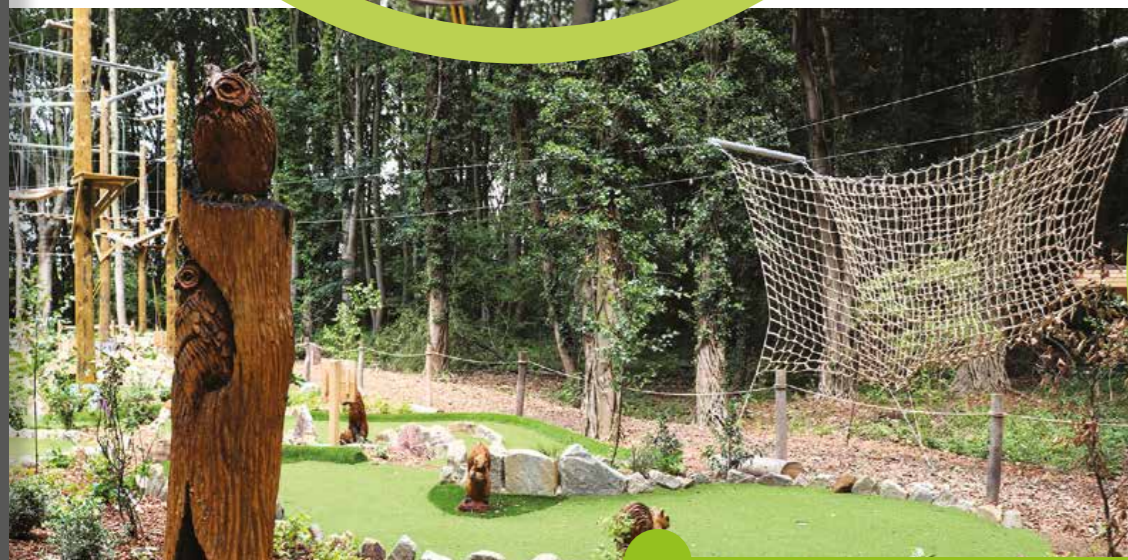
- High adrenaline adventure – which can attract a more adventurous demographic
- More accessible for more people – as there is less physical exertion than high ropes
- Can be incorporated into the end of a high ropes course, or become a course finale
- The opportunity to enjoy a tandem zip wire with a friend – perfect for enhancing the experience
- Can be anything from 5m to 1000m... the possibilities are endless!
- Visually attractive and eye-catching from afar
- Great social media opportunities
- Unique and memorable
- Encourages a sense of accomplishment-especially for visitors who may be overcoming fear!
- Piques curiosity – it could lead to a multitude of new adventures and experiences for first timers!



Space Requirements

Typically, we would recommend a minimum length of 40m for a Zip Wire attraction.

There is a great deal to consider when it comes to the construction – so an in-depth site visit is usually required to determine the possibilities initially. We would recommend this early to ascertain the feasibility of the project and would enlist the support of our Zip Wire Specialist to attend and answer any questions.



Jump Towers are the latest craze – and for good reason! They are suitable for all ages, providing the visitor is taller than 120cm... and depending on how adventurous the participant is!

Plus, there are different levels, or options, to jump from... depending on the mood!

Bounce nets are great fun – and so adaptable to suit a variety of environments. Large nets can span across open spaces which can contain soft balls, fast slides and aerial walkways... making a truly unique and interesting experience come to life!



What are the benefits of bounce nets?

- Users can bounce, slide and explore whilst experiencing a little adrenaline rush
- It's an ideal way for little ones (and big kids!) to burn off their energy and get some exercise in the great outdoors
- It can be installed in all settings: indoor or outdoor
- Can be installed above existing activities below
- Multiple options – including vertical climb to venture between layers, which can be arranged in any shape to suit the area available
- Suitable for all ages... including parents!
- Great fun and a unique overall experience
- No PPE required
- Minimal staff training required
- No kitting up time, allowing for higher throughput
- Durable structures lasting 15-25 years
- Nets can last 3-7 years, depending on the upkeep
- Can be a completely bespoke design and incorporate tree houses, or anything that the imagination can create!

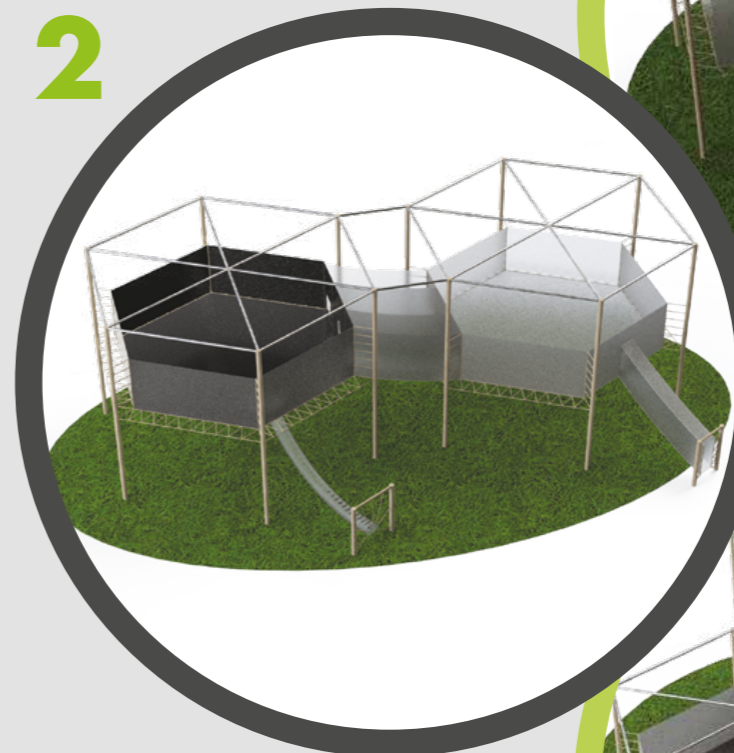


Bounce Net Options

We have three different options depending on space and budget.

- 1** The first is a singular bounce net design, with a net access ramp and a net slide to the ground level.
- 2** The second includes two bounce nets, featuring an angled net ramp between nets one and two. There are net slides to ground level, as well as slides between nets one and two. This also features an angled net ramp between the two structures.
- 3** The third option, of three bounce nets, is where the adventure can really take off! With angled net ramps between the nets, slides between the nets on both levels and finally a slide to the ground level, this will allow for plenty of exploration to burn the energy.

Based on a recent UK project build at a shopping centre, the venue created an adventure golf, high ropes course, and a zip wire finale. There is a throughput of 2,000 visitors, over a two-week period during Easter. This generated revenue in excess of £45k within this time frame. This was also a record-breaking weekend for the centre – with an increased footfall of 20%
