

DEFENCE INNOVATION VISION


- •Generating ideas and putting them into practice to give us an edge over our adversaries.

- •Ultimately for innovation to be successful, ideas must be exploited.




THE DEFENCE INNOVATION UNIT

 - Spread Best practice and encourage collaboration
- Identify and break down barriers to Exploiting Innovation across Defence

Project HECLA - A Case Study

 Experimentation with glider UUVs to understand impact on HM collect in support of ASW – project will deliver near real-time data to ASW operations in 18 months.



Creates MASS through a semiautonomous sensor network

Extends our **REACH** by achieving semi-persistent presence.

Enhances **LEATHALITY** by enabling us to position weapon carriers in the optimum position to prosecute a target.

Operational prototype delivered to the user at pace, with the ability to scale for operations and transfer into core.
