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Introduction

Content Development

- This is a 'live' resource which has a robust assurance and governance process.
- Content is based and updated on:
 - National Guidance and best practice
 - Operational requirement
 - Annual review (minimum requirement)
- Any deviation from national guidance needs to be justified.
- Content is developed through relevant DCA/DSAs as SMEs using their clinical teams for support.
- Collaborative approach with training providers to ensure CGOs and course content match.
- Process built in for user feedback.



 - Printable.
 - Desk top app for housekeeper/deployed IT.
- Secure:
 - UK Based server.
 - SSL in place.
 - Multiple firewalls/protection.
 - Back up servers.
