




As Mayor, I'm supporting OneLondon

We are developing this as a Learning Health System: an improvement loop where data about care drives research which drives better care




# Case-study: Innovation Partnership with South East London Cancer Alliance

**AIM:** Supporting the South East London Cancer Alliance (SELCA) to understand the market for personalised care platforms to inform future personalised care module development or procurement.

**ACTIVITIES:** Compiled the **needs articulation** and developed **inclusion criteria**; researched the market to identify solutions meeting the inclusion criteria; **shortlisted suppliers** and assessed functionality of solutions; produced a **market review report** to inform decision making.


#### IMPACT
