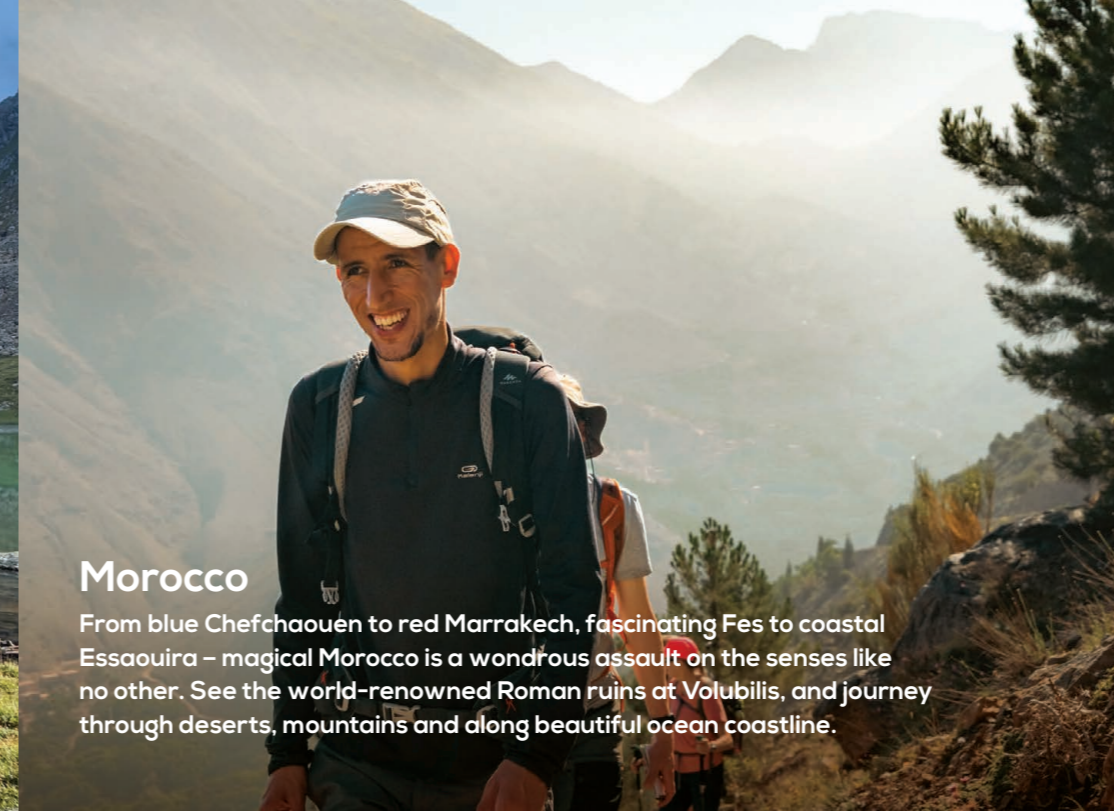
Northern Spain
