



Twin sisters *Star Clipper* and *Star Flyer* are true Clipper Ships reflecting their proud heritage in every inch of their polished brass and gleaming charm. They are modern small ships in every way, created for adventure-loving passengers looking for the tradition and romance of the legendary era of sailing ships but with the comforts and amenities of the present day. As identical twins, they are both 379 feet long and each carry 166 guests in pampered comfort, over 36,000 square feet of sails. Sixteen sails billowing in the wind.

NAUTICAL HERITAGE

Each ship offers spacious accommodation and expansive teak decks with ample space for walking and relaxation. In fact, you'll find that these ships offer more outdoor space per passenger than most conventional cruise ships.





You may think you know the Caribbean, but visiting this gorgeous part of the globe on board one of our tall ships allows for a completely fresh perspective.



On Star Flyer, you'll have a choice of itineraries visiting either the Leeward Islands, sailing south, or the Treasure Islands, sailing west, departing from beautiful St. Maarten. Royal Clipper sails from Barbados, heading north to the Windward Islands or west to the Grenadine Islands.

The opportunity to attend special events while in the Caribbean make these sailings all the more appealing. *Royal Clipper* calls on exotic Martinique during their Mardi Gras festivities, allowing guests to experience the magic of this island's French-meets-Caribbean culture. Serious sailing fans will want to check out our Super Yacht itineraries on *Star Flyer*, which put guests in St. Barts during the popular Bucket Regatta. 

Central America



With an expansive rain forest and beaches flanking both the Pacific Ocean and Caribbean Sea, Costa Rica is one of the most biodiverse countries in the world.

The uninhabited Isla Iguana is a wildlife reserve located on Panama's Pacific coast where guests can watch the colorful frigate birds fly in formation and visit expansive coral reefs containing more than 500 marine species including rare olive ridley sea turtles. Travelers looking for the "deserted island" moment will love Isla San Jose in the Pearl Islands, a 44 kilometer slice of paradise.

With more than 800 miles of coastline and spectacular coral reefs, Costa Rica offers incredible opportunities for snorkelling. Star Clippers' water sports program allows guests to borrow snorkelling equipment for the duration of the sailing, which they can use to their hearts content.

Port Charges: Must be added to all rates and are subject to change at any time. No discounts apply.

Single Supplement Rates: A single supplement fare is available at 150% of the published cruise tariff for categories 2-6 selected in the season in which the passengers are travelling. It is available at 200% for category 1 cabins, Deluxe Suites and the Owner's Cabin or Suites. Single space is capacity controlled.

Guaranteed Single: A guaranteed single rate is a special rate for a passenger wishing to sail alone in the cabin. This is a fixed rate whereby Star Clippers will choose and assign the cabin from any cabin category upon embarkation. This rate is based on availability and is capacity controlled. No other discount is applicable on this rate.

Back to Back Cruises: If you wish to sail 1 or more consecutive cruises, they will be discounted by 5%. This discount is combinable with Early Booking Discount and is valid for all categories except guaranteed single.

Cruise Documents: When boarding, all passengers must have their cruise ticket, passport, that is valid at least six months beyond the end of your cruise, or ID and visas (where necessary). We recommend that travel documents be kept with hand luggage.

Your cabin: Your cabin is ingeniously designed for comfort and efficiency, with private bathroom, air-conditioning, region TV/free multimedia DVD player, hairdryer and is equipped with a private safe located inside the closet. Operating instructions are posted on the inside of the closet door. Because each passenger is responsible for items kept in his/her stateroom, it is recommended to place items of special value in the complimentary safe. All cabins are non-smoking.

Personal funds and credit cards: Each passenger will receive a personalised identification card that will be used to charge services and products provided on board the ship. The identification cards must be presented each time a passenger boards the ship. Passengers are advised to carry their identification card with them at all times. Each account can be settled in cash Euros or credit cards on the final day of the cruise. The following credit cards are accepted on board: Visa, Mastercard, American Express.

Electrical Appliances: Star Clipper and Star Flyer ships provide passengers with 110-volt (American and European plugs). Royal Clipper has 220-volt (European plug). Each cabin is equipped with 2 hairdryers.

Telephone communications: Cabins are equipped with a direct dial telephone that passengers can use while at sea. On Royal Clipper, all calls will be billed to their on board account. On Star Clipper and Star Flyer a credit card may be used directly. Should someone wish to contact a passenger at sea, they may do so by calling the Star Clippers' office and the information will be forwarded to the ship. Please note that telephone and internet communication during Ocean Crossings cannot be guaranteed. Wifi information is available from the Purser's office. Internet rates will be charged to passengers' on board account.

E-mails: E-mail and WI-FI services are available on board wherever technically possible (depending on Satellite connections).

Watersports: All passengers have access to a watersports programme which includes: snorkelling, kayaking, Laser sailing, water-skiing, paddle boards and windsurfing (where possible, subject to weather conditions and local authorities).

Please note: all watersports are complimentary except for scuba diving. Star Clippers takes no responsibilities for scuba diving. Certified divers should contact local dive operators.

Gratuities/Tipping policy: Gratuities on board the ship are not included in the cruise fare and are at the sole discretion of each individual passenger based on the level of services performed. We suggest 10 Euros per person, per night on board: 70 Euros for a 7 night cruise.

Children: Children are welcome on board Star Clippers. We regret that we are unable to accept children on board aged under 6 months, minimum 1 year during ocean crossings. While there is no structured programme providing supervision and care for young children, they are invited to participate in shipboard activities suited to their ability. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult. Children occupying cabins as the third person will be charged the third person rate when availability permits.

Special Occasions: Passengers celebrating a birthday, anniversary, honeymoon or other special occasion during their cruise should advise their travel professional or Star Clippers at the time of booking.

Weddings: Confirmation Wedding Ceremonies may be held on board officiated by the Captain. Couples must be legally married prior to boarding and must provide recent (within three months) proof of marriage. Requests to be made through your Travel Professional or Star Clippers.

In some cases, where we are not able to do so for reasons of insolvency, an alternative ATOL holder may provide you with the services you have bought or a suitable alternative (at no extra cost to you). You agree to accept that in those circumstances the alternative ATOL holder will perform those obligations and you agree to pay any money outstanding to be paid by you under your contract to that alternative ATOL holder, in which case you will be entitled to claim under the ATOL scheme (or your credit card issuer where applicable).
3.3 From 1st October 2012 you will receive an ATOL certificate for all ATOL protected flight or flight inclusive holidays booked with FOT trading as Star Clippers. This lists the flight, accommodation, car hire and or other services that are financially protected, where information is provided on what this means for the passenger and who to contact if things go wrong.
3.4 AS a member of ABTA (membership, number V3510), FOT

5.6 On board payments by credit card or American Express charge card are subject to the surcharges at 4.3 above. In case of failure to settle an on board account in full before leaving the ship, an administration charge of £75 will apply.

Cancellation or curtailment by Passenger
6.1 A Booking may be cancelled subject to notice to FOT in writing and payment to FOT of a cancellation fee in accordance with the following scales:

7.4 Where before departure it is not reasonably possible or practical to provide the cruise holiday (even by making changes) due to an event of FOT or Aligume, then FOT will give notice of cancellation of the holiday. Conduct, Safety and Security

Claims

It is not made on behalf of, and does not commit any airline mentioned or any other airline whose services are used during the course of the holiday. Notwithstanding this any rules, regulations, terms and conditions published by any such airline will apply.
15.2 Published prices for fly/cruises are inclusive of specially negotiated airfares which are subject to availability and may include an amount to cover flight disruption insurance.
