

#### **WALK ONE**

#### 5 MILES - 200M ASCENT/DESCENT

Your first walk is a circuit departing directly from the hotel. Your guide will take you via historic coastal paths, across sandy beaches and coves to your destination, where you can take in the spectacular views across the cliffs and visit the Devils Tower (Torre Diablo).



#### **WALK TWO**

#### 6 MILES - 150M ASCENT

A beautiful coastal route starting in the charming village of La Herradura. As you walk, explore the coastline to Marina del Ese, a picturesque marina with beautiful yachts and a lovely waterfront setting. Continue on to Almuñécar where you will be rewarded with fantastic views of the Mediterranean Sea.



#### **WALK THREE**

#### 5.5 MILES - 80M ASCENT

Today's walk starts in the charming white-washed village of Frigiliana before heading out to the coast. You will walk through picturesque countryside, passing olive groves & citrus orchards along the way. Continuing towards Nerja, take in the breathtaking views of the Med & explore the town in your free time.

6 MILES - 125M ASCENT/DESCENT You will head into the dunes of Cala Agulla and around the peninsula of Cala Ratiada, via Cala Lliteras, before arriving at the lighthouse, from where you can see fantastic views of neighbouring island Menorca.



#### **WALK TWO**

5.5 MILES - 154M ASCENT, 299M DESCENT Lovely walk around the natural area & park of Levante. You will cross into a woodland area & follow a track with different terrain and a few steeper sections that will lead you to the unspoilt bay of Cala Torta. There you will have the chance to have a swim before continuing to Cala Mitjana where the walk will finish.



#### **WALK THREE**

6 MILES - 257M ASCENT, 285M DESCENT Petra, a town in the centre of the island, famous for its history about Fray, a missionary who founded many towns & missions on the west coast of the USA in California. You climb up to a small hill with a monastery on top to take in views of Alcudia Bay & the Serra de Tramuntana mountain range.

#### 5 MILES - 185M ASCENT/DESCENT

Bound by two rivers and a haven of peace and solitude. Rosário might as well be an island — as its name 'Ilha' suggests. This delightful walk follows a watercourse (levada) around the hillside, trapped between cliffs and the river. You will then complete the circuit of the walk via quiet country lanes.



#### **WALK TWO**

#### 5 MILES - 80M ASCENT

Luz to Ponta da Piedade. The starting point of this walk is the fishing village of Luz. You will walk uphill & along the picturesque coastline. There you will take a short transfer to Lagos. The town is closely associated with Henry the Navigator, and was the starting port of many Portuguese voyages of discovery in the 15th & 16th century.



#### **WALK THREE**

#### 5 MILES - 150M ASCENT

Praia de Marinha to Carvoeiro. You will follow narrow paths in an area where the cliffs are made up of different colours of rock here there are excellent photo opportunities with impressive blowholes, passing the Alfanzina lighthouse before continuing to the picturesque town of Carvoeiro in time for lunch.

#### 5 MILES - 250M ASCENT

Visit Italy's longest medieval bridge. Wander through the old town, then traverse smart villas, olive groves, and greenhouses to reach Old Bussana, a once-empty village now thriving with a Bohemian artist community since the 1960s.

#### **WALK TWO**

#### 9 MILES - 500M ASCENT/DESCENT

Begin your walk from Bordighera's seafront, winding through the old town to a picturesque valley of palm trees leading to Sasso. Continue along the old road to Seborga. For a shorter route, opt for a local bus from Sasso or Seborga back to Bordighera.

#### **WALK THREE**

7 MILES - 200M ASCENT/DESCENT
Your last walk starts in the
picturesque town of Menton,
ascending to Roquebrune village on
Mont Gros, famed for hang-gliding
and stunning Monte Carlo vistas.
Explore Monaco's port and lower
town before sightseeing in
Monte-Carlo.

Bordighera, a coastal gem on the Italian Riviera, captivates with its Mediterranean allure, boasting a perfect climate, palm-lined promenades, and a rich history dating back to the 19th century. Beloved by artists like Claude Monet, it exudes timeless elegance with its historic landmarks and tranquil atmosphere. Nearby excursions unveil hidden treasures like Taggia's old town

and the re imagined village of Old Bussana. Seborga enchants with its picturesque charm and unique aspirations for sovereignty.

Optional visits to Villa Rothschild and Nice add cultural richness, while Menton's serene beauty leads to Monte Carlo's glitzy allure, completing a journey through Riviera splendour.

#### **WALK ONE**

#### 2.5 MILES - 150M ASCENT/DESCENT

Take the train up the lake to the station of Fondotoce before ascending 150m to the little hamlet of Montorfano, which has stunning views over Lake Maggiore. You continue down a gently sloping path to Mergozzo, a small village on the shores of its own little lake.

#### **WALK TWO**

#### 5 MILES - 350M ASCENT/DESCENT

Begin your walk through the clustered medieval village houses, linked by seemingly random arched passageways. You then follow a mule track past orchards, fine old villas, a 14th century tower & a chapel, from where there are lovely views out over the lake, towards the Borromean islands & the Alps beyond.

#### **WALK THREE**

#### 5 MILES - 500M ASCENT

You catch the bus to Belgirate and follow a route through the woods above the lake, climbing towards the villages of Falchetti and Passera, before descending into Stresa.



Traditionally lower key than its neighbours Mallorca (Majorca) and Ibiza, the island of Menorca may be just 30 miles long and 10 miles across, but it hosts a world of contrasts. The north is comparatively lush and green, with extensive bays and long headlands. The south is much rockier with many caves. At the eastern end lies the island's capital Mahon, a historic City well worth exploring. To the west lies Ciutadella, a former island capital, again with impressive city walls and harbour, much quieter than the capital. But, it is the island's unspoilt beaches and coves that may impress you most of all, our resort area of Son Bou is home to one of the best of them.

#### **WALK ONE** 8 MILES - 300M ASCENT/DESCENT

The South. This is a circular walk from the hotel, passing through Son Bute Valley. Your guide will lead you through the Ravine of Binigaus, passing the Coloms Cave and walking along the coast back to Son Bou.



#### **WALK TWO**

5 MILES - 100M ASCENT/DESCENT

The North. Starting at Cape of Cavalleria, the island's most northerly point, you walk along the coast in the direction of Cala Pregonda. After your walk, you return by coach, visiting 'El Toro', Menorca's 358m-high 'mountain' to take in the stunning view.



#### **WALK THREE**

8 MILES - 100M ASCENT/DESCENT

The East. You transfer to the Cape of Favaritx, with its black rocks and follow a path by the S'Albufera lagoon to the unspoilt fishing village of Es Garau, set in the beautiful nature reserve of S'Albufera Nature Park.

Cyprus is an ancient land of mystery, legend, beauty and love. At the crossroads of three continents, the area has a long history of invasions.

If it wasn't for its mountain ranges, whose winter snows irrigate the island, Cyprus would be desert instead of the lush, green landscapes you now find here. Paphos was the capital for 600 years and its visible archaeological legacy has led to the whole town being placed on the UNESCO World Heritage List. Two of the walks included in the itinerary highlight the Akamas peninsula – an area of rocky coves, sandy bays on the coast and picturesque villages inland.

#### 5 MILES - 250M ASCENT/DESCENT

The Akamas Peninsula, You first visit the nature reserve area of the Akamas peninsula, following the trail that Adonis used on his way to meet Aphrodite (or so the locals say).



#### **WALK TWO**

#### 4.5 MILES - 300M ASCENT/DESCENT

Panayia and the Vouni Trail. Today's walk starts at the village of Panayia. The path goes through vineyards and amid unusual limestone rock formations. Before returning to Paphos, you will visit Chrysorogiatissa monastery founded in 1152.



#### **WALK THREE**

#### 5 MILES

The Troodos Mountains. These impressive, often snow-capped, mountains are the backbone of Cyprus - the highest peak, Mount Olympus, rises to 6000ft. This is a 5-mile trail around the mountain, starting and finishing on the road to Chionistra, crossing ski runs and with stunning views on all sides.

Sprawled across a mountain slope some 1,475 feet above the Mediterranean Sea, the white washed centre of Mijas Pueblo still has the look of an old Andalucian village.

The marble and limestone Sierra de Mijas is crossed with mountain valleys and has a variety of walking paths and routes with hidden beauty, views and landscapes.

Mijas has a folk museum of which its prime focus is Picasso's ceramic works, where 41 are on display, as well as some of his paintings and others by Dali and Miro.

Malaga is easily accessible on public transport, or you could spend a day at the beach in nearby Fuengirola.



#### 5 MILES - 400M ASCENT/DESCENT

An introduction to Mijas itself, with its narrow alleys, broad squares & the 'Camino del Calvario', a pilgrims' path of the Way of the Cross up to the Hermitage, situated on the side of the Sierra, from where there are superb views over the coast.



#### **WALK TWO**

#### 5 MILES - 350M ASCENT/DESCENT

You will head northeast and visit the quarry near the hotel, if you are lucky, you will be able to see ibex and their young. After the quarry, before your descent back to your Mijas hotel, following a path, you can enjoy magnificent views towards Africa



#### **WALK THREE**

#### 5 MILES - 500M ASCENT

Starting your walk near Benalmadena Pueblo, a pretty town in the hills. The trail follows a ridge – on a clear day you can see Gibraltar & Africa! Your destination is Calamorro, from where the cable car whisks you back down the mountain to 'civilisation'!

#### 8 MILES - 270M ASCENT/DESCENT

Your first walk starts in Mesendorf, taking you over the hills & through the meadows to Viscri. After your walk, enjoy a traditional lunch in a local house & explore the village before a tour of Viscri's UNESCO-listed fortified church.

#### **WALK TWO**

#### 7 MILES - 350M ASCENT, 400M DESCENT

Explore the hills of Piatra Craiului, a 25km long beautiful mountain range of southern Carpathians. You will cross through Zarnesti Gorges & the stunning mountain village of Magura, before visiting Bran, the home of Dracula.

#### **WALK THREE**

#### 8 MILES - 80M ASCENT, 310M DESCENT

Explore Postavaru & Tampa, taking in the breathtaking valley views of Bucegi, Piatra Mare & the Piatra Craiului mountains. From Tampa either walk or take the gentle cable car ride down into Brasov.

#### **WALK FOUR**

#### 2.5 MILES - 350M ASCENT, 100M DESCENT

Explore the Piatra Mare mountain range, a small mountain range located South East of Brasov. The highlight of today will be the Seven Ladders Canyon, 160m long & 55m high with 7 main stairs, which you will ascend with the mountain guides.

Transylvania is a land of dramatic mountain scenery, idyllic rural countryside, lush pastures, wild flower meadows, Saxon medieval towns and villages, and of course vampires!

Travelling around Transylvania has

been described as 'the last truly medieval landscape in Europe'.

Highlights of this holiday include a visit to the world famous home of Bram Stokers 'Count Dracula', & climbing the unique Seven Ladders Canyon.

#### **WALK ONE**

5 MILES - 100M ASCENT/DESCENT

Your first walk will visit the enchanting forested Ojcowski National Park, Poland's natural gem that thrives with lush greenery and diverse wildlife. Some of the wildlife that can be found include wild European Bison, Wild Boar, Red Deer, Pine Marten's & more.

#### **WALK TWO**

8 MILES - 500M ASCENT, 400M DESCENT Travel by local bus to walk through the Koscieliska Valley, Przyslop Mietusi Pass and Malei Laki Vallev to the Grzybowiec Pass at a height of 1330m. Your guide will then lead you down the Strazyska Valley to . Zakopane.

#### **WALK THREE**

8 MILES - 550M ASCENT, 600M DESCENT Visit the Slovakian border from where you walk back to Zakopane following a trail through Hala Gasienicowa, the alpine meadow (1500m) and then back to

Zakopane.



#### 5 MILES - 360M ASCENT/DESCENT

Ascend to the ruins of the Moorish castle that dates from the 11th century. From the castle there is a stunning 360° panoramic view.

#### **WALK TWO**

#### 6 MILES - 315M ASCENT, 625M DESCENT

Explore the adjacent Jalon Valley, famous for its vineyard's fine wines. The route starts at the summit of the Coll de Rates with panoramic views of the Tarbena Valley, the Sierra de Ferrer and the Jalon Valley.

#### **WALK THREE**

#### 7.5 MILES - 620M ASCENT/DESCENT

We start by joining the old Tarbena to Castells de Castells road to climb up to a stunning viewpoint. The route continues to Font del Olbis to enjoy the view and drink cool spring water straight from the mountain.

#### **WALK FOUR**

#### 6.5 MILES - 145M ASCENT.540M DESCENT

Leaving the village along an old mule trail, you will climb cobblestone steps to a medieval tower. Descending into the valley, our route takes us along the foot of the Sierra de Ferrer with the trail emerging at Picasarries.

Can Perles, based in Tàrbena, is a small mountain village with a population of 650 perched 560 metres above the Mediterranean

Tàrbena is a traditional farming community where the villagers tend orchards of olives, almonds and fruit-trees on terraces etched into the steep terrain by the Moors over a millennia ago.

The rugged scenery offers fantastic panoramic views of the surrounding mountains and valleys, the diverse history and biology of the area provides a wealth of interesting features to discover.

### **WALK ONE**

#### 6 MILES - 630M ASCENT/DESCENT

This is a circular walk characterised by stunning small white villages, rural landscapes and steep sided gorges with abundant flora and fauna. Visiting Fondales, Ferreirola, Atalbeitar, Portugos, Capilerilla and Pitres.

#### **WALK TWO**

#### 5.5 MILES - 200M ASCENT/DESCENT

A superb walk starting high above the town of Capileira, walking towards the Sierra Nevada mountain range. You follow an irrigation channel with waterfalls before heading uphill to reach an old cortijo. The return is made alongside a higher irrigation channel before entering a pine forest and slowly returning to the start point.
