THE HEALTH & SAFETY AT WORK

It is a condition of entry into the event that every exhibitor, contractor, sub-contractor, supplier and their agents comply with the Health & Safety at Work Act and all other legislation covering the venue and event participation. The exhibitor accepts that it is their legal and moral responsibility to ensure that their own and others health and safety is not put at risk by their actions (or inactions) throughout the tenancy.

INSURANCE

Exhibitors must insure their display items, property or articles of any kind against all risks and have third-party insurance taken out to cover their representatives or agents on duty. The Exhibitor shall insure against, indemnity and hold the Event Organiser harmless in respect of all costs, claims demands and expenses to which the Event Organiser may be in any way be subject as a result of any loss or injury arising to any person (including members of the public, Event Organiser's staff, agents or contractors), or property. The Exhibitor ensures to have required insurance coverage.

Exhibitors will train and make their stand staff aware of the potential risks present onsite and will provide them with a copy of the manual, event regulations, and venue regulations. The exhibits, demonstrations and work practices displayed will cause NO HAZARDS to either themselves or to others onsite.

The exhibitor will make available a copy of their own company's Health & Safety policy, and their stand staff will be sufficiently instructed and trained in matters relating to Health & Safety to carry out their tasks competently.
