If additional vertical space is required to accommodate content, blocks with 3 / 4 or 1 / 2 of the logo x height may be used instead.


Always center text along the block's centerline. Ideally, leaving a one-block margin around the text. If more space is needed to fit content, ensure the text is visually aligned within the block.


Going by the grid, every block should have a minimum of a half square margin around text on all sides.




Not enough margin on top and bottom and too wide of margins on left and right.


Moving Parts Rules



Text Dividers may be used to divide sections of text or to point to specific areas on maps, infographics, etc.



The Dash graphic element can be used on any piece where space permits. It can be positioned vertically or horizontally but should not be placed over any other elements. The Dash can sit against blocks or be placed behind Iradium shapes, provided it doesn't create visual clutter. While pink is the preferred color for the Dash, other colors may be used if pink becomes too dominant in the design.






Iridium Shapes should be used on any piece where space allows. The whole shape can be shown, or just a partial area.



Tagline should not be used on all pieces—only on larger scaled graphics. Three stacked options available.



These text box colors are always used for dates and may be used behind headlines and subheaders as well.



These text box colors are only used behind headlines, subheaders, speaker name/title, etc. Not Dates.

Zeus is the official mascot of Distributech, used for:

- + Real-life activations (the Zeus suit!)
- + Chatbot
- + Graphic Icon

The challenge is to have control over when and where Zeus is used, so he doesn't:

- confuse or add complexity to compositions
- become over-used and compromise the overall quality cues of the events
- used as a 'sticking plaster' to add warmth to communications, where attention should be on creating engaging content

Logo, text, and blocks are aligned within full squares of the grid.





Logo and blocks are aligned within full squares of the grid — text is aligned on center line within block.




Use blocks behind dates and any text that should be called out. Blocks can also be used over busy photos to create contrast. A multiplied transparent dash can be used over photos to add a campaign element without taking away from the photo imagery.
