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## PHYSICAL DISTANCING



### WHAT

### ACTIONS

#### CROWD DENSITY & FLOOR PLANNING

- Professional / social distancing measures- 6' from each person
- One way entrances and exits for building and exhibit hall
- Floor stickers and signs will be placed throughout the Spokane Convention
- Center instructing and reminding attendees to socially distance

#### REGISTRATION

- Encouraging pre-registration to allow for more streamlined badge pick-up process
- Regular cleaning of all equipment
- Easy to use self-serve options available for badge pickup
- Reduced contact at registration areas

#### SOCIAL EVENTS & CONFERENCE ROOMS

- Social distancing measures in classrooms and events
- Enhanced cleaning of audio visual equipment between speakers
- Disposable microphone covers
- All social events will have an attendant serving food and beverages
- HYDROVISION International team to partner with offsite venues about safety protocols

#### ELIMINATING HANDSHAKES

- No handshake policy
- No handshake signs

#### FOOD & BEVERAGE

- Concessions will offer pre-packaged food or require an attendant to serve the food
- Seating at dining locations to be arranged to comply with crowd density standards

#### MONITORING & CONTROL

- Our team will be trained on the 4 Cornerstones and available to help enforce social distancing measures on the show floor.
- Temperature checks will be required by all staff, attendees and exhibitors every morning

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## CLEANING & HYGIENE



### WHAT

### ACTIONS

#### CONVENTION CENTER CLEANING

- The Spokane Convention Center is GBAC Gold Star Certified. GBAC (Global Biorisk Advisory Council) a division of the Worldwide Cleaning Industry Association, is the cleaning industry's only outbreak prevention, response, and recovery accreditation for facilities. GBAC STAR is the gold standard of prepared facilities.
- Continuous sanitation throughout the Spokane Convention Center has been enhanced and increased

#### BOOTH CLEANING

- HYDROVISION International will recommend cleaning tips in exhibitor manual
- Ability to purchase cleaning kits, in-booth janitorial services and plexiglass for booths
- Increased signage and onsite information about booth cleaning onsite
- Guidelines have been set with Spokane Convention Center about sampling and food handouts
- Encourage exhibitors to clean and disinfect high touch point areas

#### HAND SANITIZERS / HANDS FREE

- Hand sanitizer station locations at entrances, lobbies, bathrooms and throughout the halls

#### WASTE MANAGEMENT

- Increased frequency of waste removal

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## PROTECT & DETECT



### WHAT

### ACTIONS

#### FACIAL COVERINGS

- CDC approved facial coverings will be required at the event
- Enhanced communication to exhibitors, visitors and speakers of requirements
- HYDROVISION International & Spokane Convention Center staff will wear masks

#### FIRST AID & MEDICAL SUPPORT

- Increase communication and awareness about location of medic facilities in messaging before and during the show

#### GLASS SNEEZE GUARDS/ PLEXIGLASS

- Plexiglass added in key areas where physical distancing is limited
- Exhibitors will have the option to purchase plexiglass for their booths
- Food and beverage stations / Concessions to have sneeze guards where required

#### PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

- We will follow all local regulations for the required use of PPE
- Enhanced signage promoting proper way to wear masks & gloves

#### EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLANS

- Prior to the event, the HYDROVISION International team will work with venue and medic to determine an emergency response plan and communicate to all staff attending the event including a chain of command for communicating emergency response

#### EMPLOYEE SCREENING

- Designated room for staff only to be screened each morning.
- Training prior to the event that staff knows how to properly wear PPE
- Staff will not be allowed to come to work if exhibiting any symptoms including fever, sore throat, chills and cough

#### QUARANTINE AREA

- The Spokane Convention Center will have a defined quarantine procedure

#### HEALTH AUTHORITY ENGAGEMENT

- Spokane Convention Center and Freeman will cooperate and share provided documents

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## COMMUNICATION



### WHAT

### ACTIONS

#### EXHIBITOR MANUALS

- Include health and safety information in the exhibitor manual along with FAQs
- HYDROVISION International will create a video of health & safety on how to protect yourself and others around you (washing hands, face masks, etc.) to be posted in exhibitor manual

#### EVENT SIGNAGE

- Health and safety signage will be located throughout the event in high traffic areas

#### PUBLIC ADDRESSES DURING SHOW

- At the beginning of all sessions / events there will be announcements to remind attendees to practice social distance
- We will make announcements throughout the day as a reminder to social distance

#### PRE-SHOW MESSAGING

- Enhanced communication leading up to the show and safety protocols through website, email, social media. Messaging to include:
  - Persons displaying COVID-19 symptoms should not attend.
  - Persons displaying COVID-19 symptoms may be refused admission
  - May prefer & should expect others to avoid shaking hands
  - Carry a personal supply of hand sanitizer, tissues & wipes in & out of the event
  - Keep up to date with public health advice for Spokane and the Spokane Convention Center. Take time to read health communications & updates from the organizer
  - Any restrictions (inc. disinfecting) placed on demonstrations / demonstration models, sampling, give-away promotional goods & materials etc. for exhibitors
