
The Speciality Coffee market in the UK is growing rapidly as consumers place a greater focus on the quality of goods they buy. Also a rise in working from home means consumers want better coffee at home as they're less likely to nip out to a coffee shop located near offices.

Current market trends suggest it is only going to continue to grow:

- Speciality Coffee Sales reached £2.2 billion in the UK last year which is a 23% Coffee Market Share and this is expected to grow at a CAGR of 11.5% over the next 5 years
- Young Adults are at the heart of this growth with 18-24 year olds accounting for 32.5% market share with 25-39 year olds being the next largest and fastest growing demographic group
- 63% of UK Consumers now consider themselves coffee enthusiasts with 40% of people are now willing to pay more for speciality coffee to ensure better quality and that farmers are paid fairly


In recent times specialty coffee in Thailand has seen rapid growth and gained international acclaim, shifting from a focus on mass production to high-quality Arabica beans.


#### SIRINYA FARM

Sirinya Coffee is a family run specialty coffee farm, roastery, and coffee shop based in the mountains of Chiang Rai province, led by Oil and Goh Chaosuwanwilai.

Sirinya is born out of a commitment to the communities of Doi Chang, as well as stewardship of the land and constantly striving for excellence in all aspects of coffee. Starting right from the beginning with the quality of the soil.







### NĂM SÔNG COFFEE ORIGIN: VIETNAM

### **DAK LAK PROVINCE**

Vietnam grows nearly 30 million bags of coffee annually, with 4 million for the internal market and 24 million to export. Most of this is grown by smallholders on plots averaging 1-1.5 hectares in size.


The Central Highlands are the heartland of Vietnamese robusta growing, with Đắk Lắk and Gia Lai taking the lion's share of that. Đắk Lắk has the lower altitude of the two, and is often seen as better quality and fuller body.

### CU DLIE M'NONG CO-OP

At Năm Sông we source our Vietnamese Coffee from the Cử Dliê M'nông Co-op, which is located in the Cử M'gar District of Đắk Lắk .

The coop received Fairtrade Certification in 2009 and currently has 84 members. Đắk Lắk's coffee farmers have a long history of cultivation, and the province has become one of the leading producers of specialty coffee in Vietnam.







### NĂM SÔNG COFFEE ORIGIN: INDONESIA

### **SUMATRA**

Indonesia is a paradise that you'll never forget. Scooter riding, waves crashing, island hopping and havingall of your belongings stolen by monkeys in Ubud. That's what it's all about.

As demand for premium, traceable coffee increases, Indonesia is establishing itself as a key player in the global specialty coffee market with vibrant beans grown in volcanic soils.

### WAHANA COFFEE ESTATE

The Wahana Estate was founded in 2006 and covers an impressive 480n hectares. The Estate uses only organic fertilisers in order to maintain a sustainable production cycle involving

using canopy trees to provide shade for coffee plants.

Wahana is also a shinig exmaple of ethical production in that is provides free housing, water and electricity, free healthcare and children's nursery services for all of their over 1,000 employees.

### BILIGIRIRANGA HILLS, KERALA

The well-known legend of coffee's arrival in India tells that 16th century Sufi saint, Baba Budan, so enthused by coffee when travelling through the Middle East during his Hajj, smuggled seven coffee beans from Yemen hidden in his beard and planted them in the Hills of Chandragiri.

Specialty coffee in India is rapidly evolving, driven by a new wave of farmers focused on quality and sustainability.

### **EKATA COFFEE**

Created by seven childhood friends from Kerala, Ekata started in 2016 with a mission to produce single origin, shade grown coffee to international standards

Since their inception they have been dedicated to giving back to the community, building schools and temples and working in partnership with the 280 acre Emerald Haven Plantation on the post harvest processing, has resulted in the production of outstanding specialty grade coffee.







### NĂM SÔNG COFFEE ORIGIN: CHINA

### YUNNAN PROVINCE

China is an intoxicating blend of old and new that has emerged dramatically in recent years as one of the world's premier coffee growing regions that has started to gain international recognition for producing exceptional speciality coffee.

Yunnan province — a mountainous and fertile land in the south west of China, is responsible for over 97% of China's coffee production.

### **BANKA FARM**

Banka farm and washing station was originally developed by Mr. Hu, a native of Yunnan, who has been producing coffee in Menglian for almost 20 years. He was one of the

first farmers to engage in large scale coffee production in the Country.

Taken over by Yunnan Coffee Traders in 2018, Banka Farm now produces both volume washed specialty lots, as well as natural and honey process micro lots.

## SAMORO, LETEFOHO the guidance

Timor-Leste is an off-thebeaten-path unique adventure filled with rugged landscapes and warm hospitality. The country is rapidly gaining recognition on the world speciality market with their high- altitude farms and ideal climate producing unique, high-quality offerings.

Coffee from Timor Leste is all organically grown in the shade of the imposing Ai-Kakeu and Ai-Samtuku trees, where only natural fertiliser is used to nourish the soils.

### **SAMORO COOPERATIVE**

We source Coffee from the Samoro Cooperative under

the guidance of lead farmer or Orlando Soares. Lying slightly east of the Cristo Liurai mountain, thiscommunity experiences warmer ambient temperatures which in turn results in warmer water during processing. This allows for more concentrated fermentation and produces a coffee featuring slightly bolder flavour notes.


