● How to Extend the pen Tip



Turn the pen gently to extend the tip. Avoid applying excessive force, this may cause damage.

Colours and the pattern might be different from the real product.

Twist the upper and bottom parts to reveal the pen tip.

● Replacing the Ink Refill

1. Pull the top and bottom parts of the body apart.

2. Unscrew this section and remove it.

3. Pull apart these parts and the core, and replace the refill.

4. Insert these parts into the lower body, then screw together to secure.

5. Reassemble the top and bottom parts of the body.

Colours and the pattern might be different from the real product.

The pen accepts D1(4-C) standard refills (2.3mm x 67mm), which are widely available worldwide.

Usage Instructions

- Use this pen solely for writing.
- Retract the pen tip when not in use or while carrying it to avoid staining clothing or bags.
- Avoid writing with the pen tip facing upward to prevent ink leakage.
- Discontinue use if the pen is damaged.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Do not leave the pen in high-temperature environments, such as inside a hot vehicle, as it is sensitive to heat and external shocks.
- Avoid dropping the pen on hard surfaces or using it in a manner that could cause damage.
- Do not wear the pen in a shirt pocket with the seat belt on, as this may cause damage.
