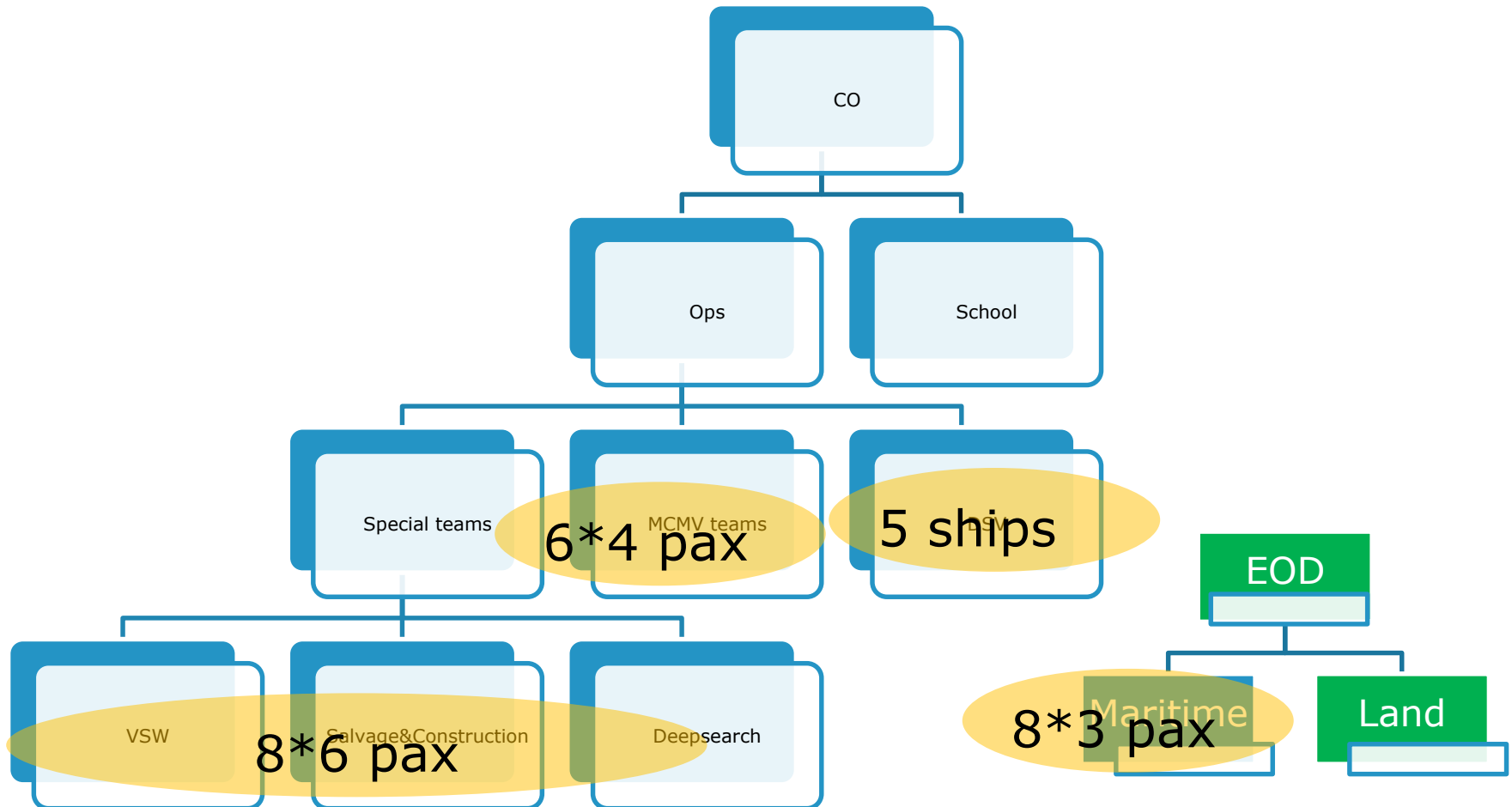

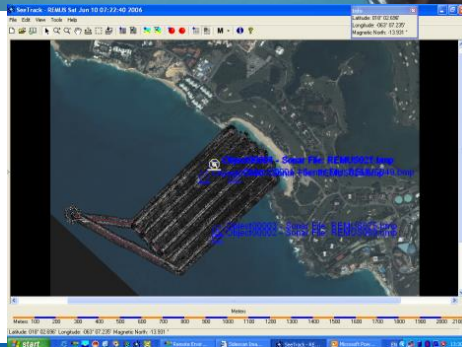

Protect two designated **Netherlands Harbours** against **static** and **dynamic** threat **above** and **underwater**

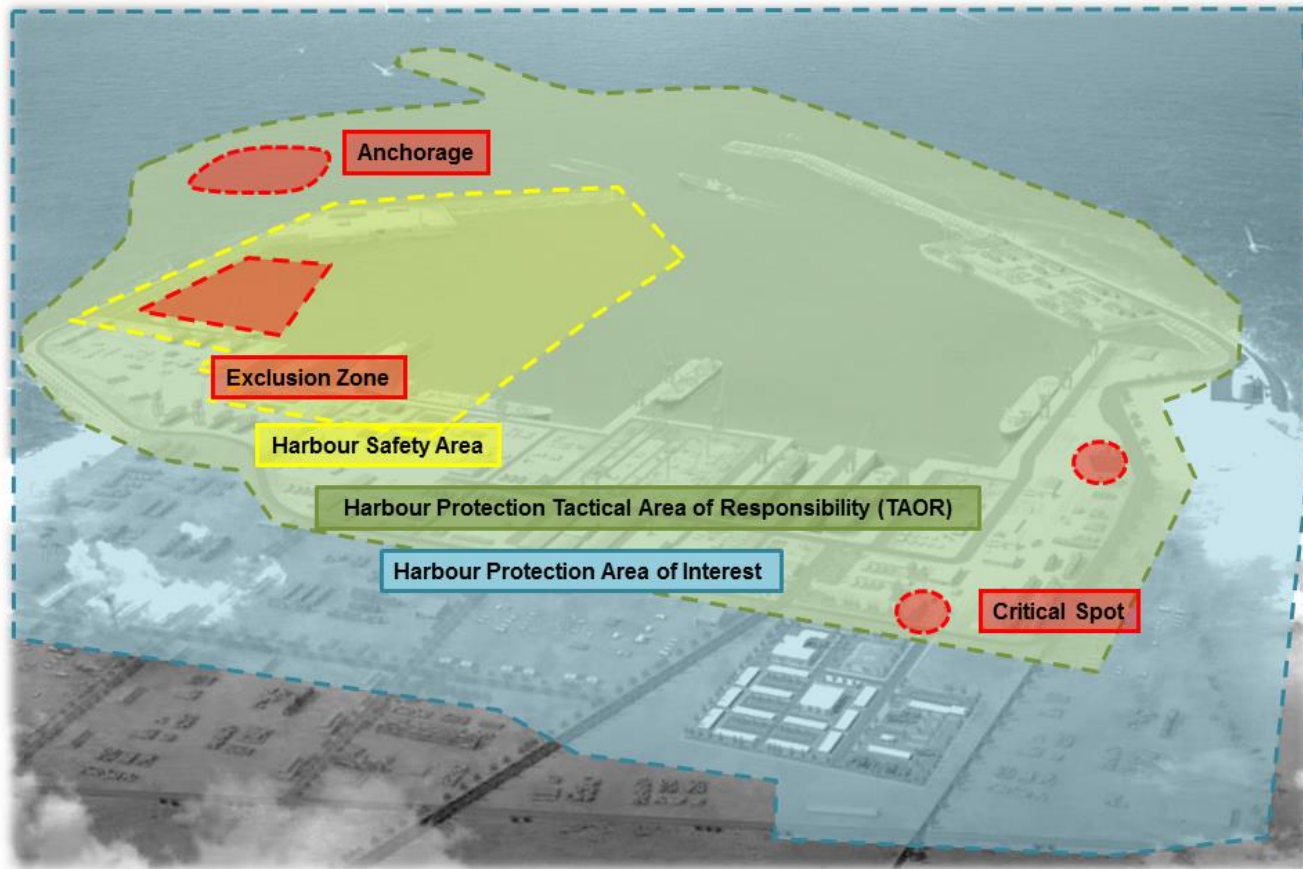

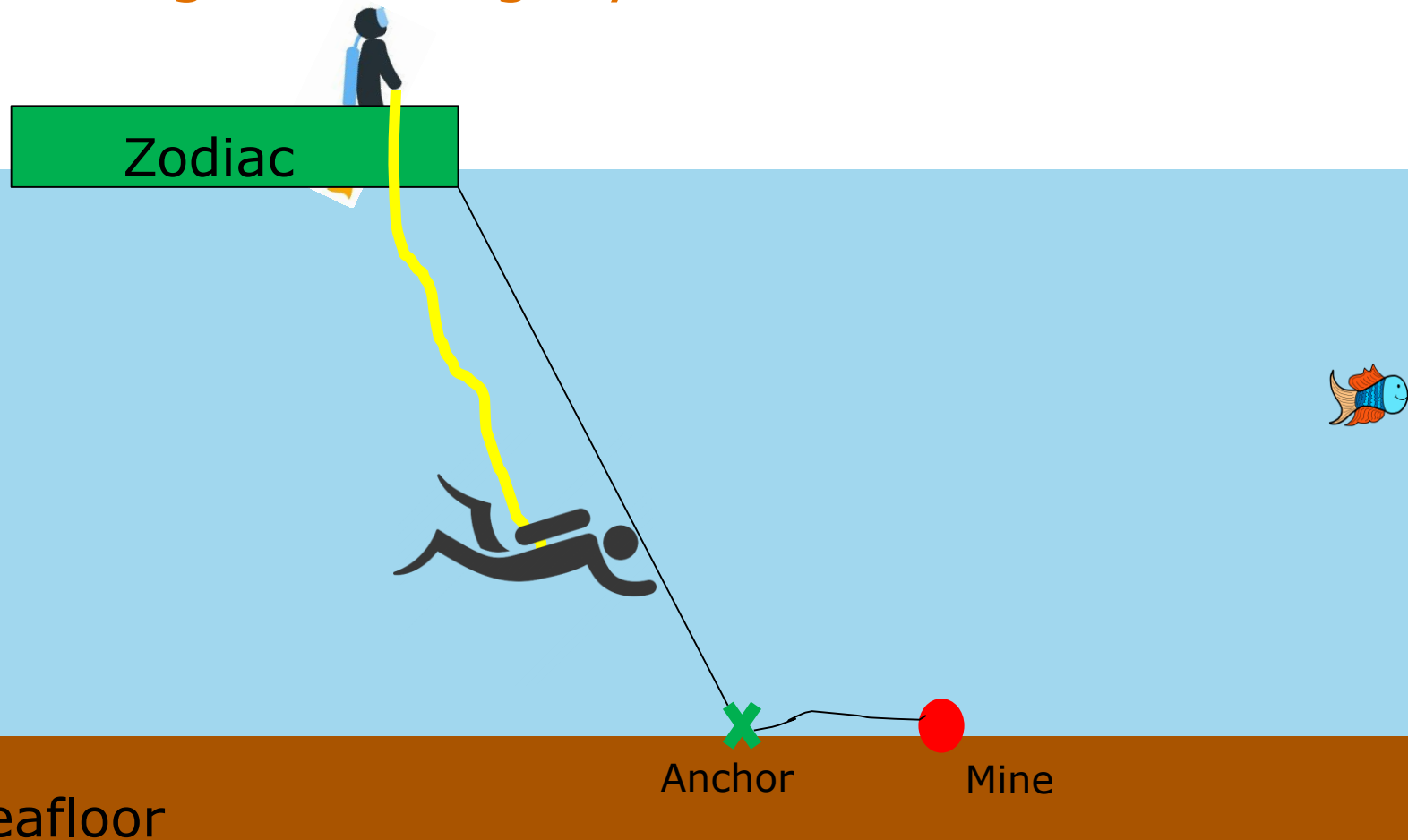
