

IO: US Joint Doctrinal Definition


 "The integrated employment, during military operations, of information-related capabilities in concert with other lines of operation to influence, disrupt, corrupt, or usurp the decisionmaking of adversaries and potential adversaries while protecting our own."


Information-Related Capability (IRC)

- "A tool, technique, or activity employed within a dimension of the information environment that can be used to create effects and operationally desirable conditions."
- Examples:
 - Electronic Warfare
 - Cyberspace Operations
 - Physical Targeting
 - Operations Security
 - Military Deception
 - Psychological Operations
 - Key Leadership Engagement
 - (and many others)












Australia's Current Approach to Information Operations

 - HQ Joint Operations Command
- Tactical
 - Joint Task Force Headquarters
 - Assigned Service capabilities







Royal Australian Navy Capabilities

- Key platforms and fittings
 - Hobart Class Destroyers
 - ANZAC Class Frigates
 - Hunter Class Frigates
 - Nulka decoy system
- Royal Australian Navy Information
 Warfare Force
 - Structure incorporating a range of information-related capabilities
- Royal Australian Navy Tactical Electronic Warfare Support Squadron
 - Embarked specialist electronic support teams
- General operations contribute to 'showing the flag'








Australian Army Capabilities

- Civil Affairs Staffs
- Force Protection Electronic
 Countermeasures
- Presence-Posture-Profile aspect of land operations

 - 462 Squadron (defensive cyber operations)


