CONTINUED COOPERATION IN SUPPORT OF AN "IN THE SPIRIT OF PARTNERSHIP FOR PEACE" SIMULATION NETWORK (PSN) CAPABILITY

BACKGROUND

In furtherance of the principles established in the Partnership for Peace (PfP) Framework Document adopted by the member states of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization in Brussels on January 10, 1994, and building on the successes of the Memorandum of Understanding between the Department of Defense of the United States of America and the Government of the Kingdom of Sweden concerning Cooperation in the Development of a Partnership for Peace Simulation Network, dated November 18, 1998, and its related efforts, the Government of the Kingdom of Sweden and the United States Department of Defense (collectively, the "Participants") have determined that continued cooperation in support of an "in the Spirit of Partnership for Peace" Simulation Network (PSN) capability would promote further training transformation and the multinational interoperability efforts of our respective countries.

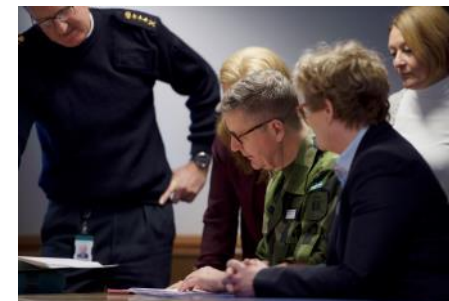




What is VIKING?



- Exercise VIKING is a training platform designed to prepare civilians, military and police together for deployment to a peace or crisis response mission area.
- A distributed computer assisted command post exercise (CAX/CPX) supported by a large number of partner nations and organizations.
- The exercise is multidimensional, multifunctional and multinational, with an emphasis on realism and current operational concepts.

- 80 Participating Civilian Organizations





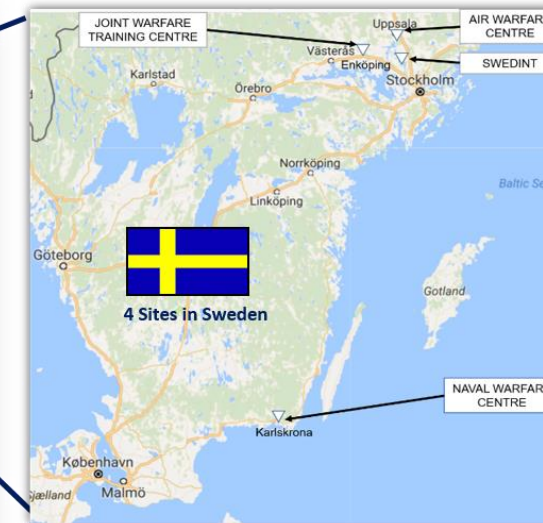

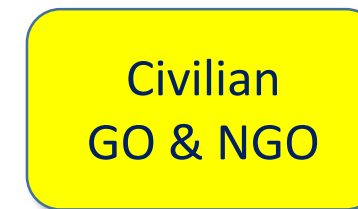

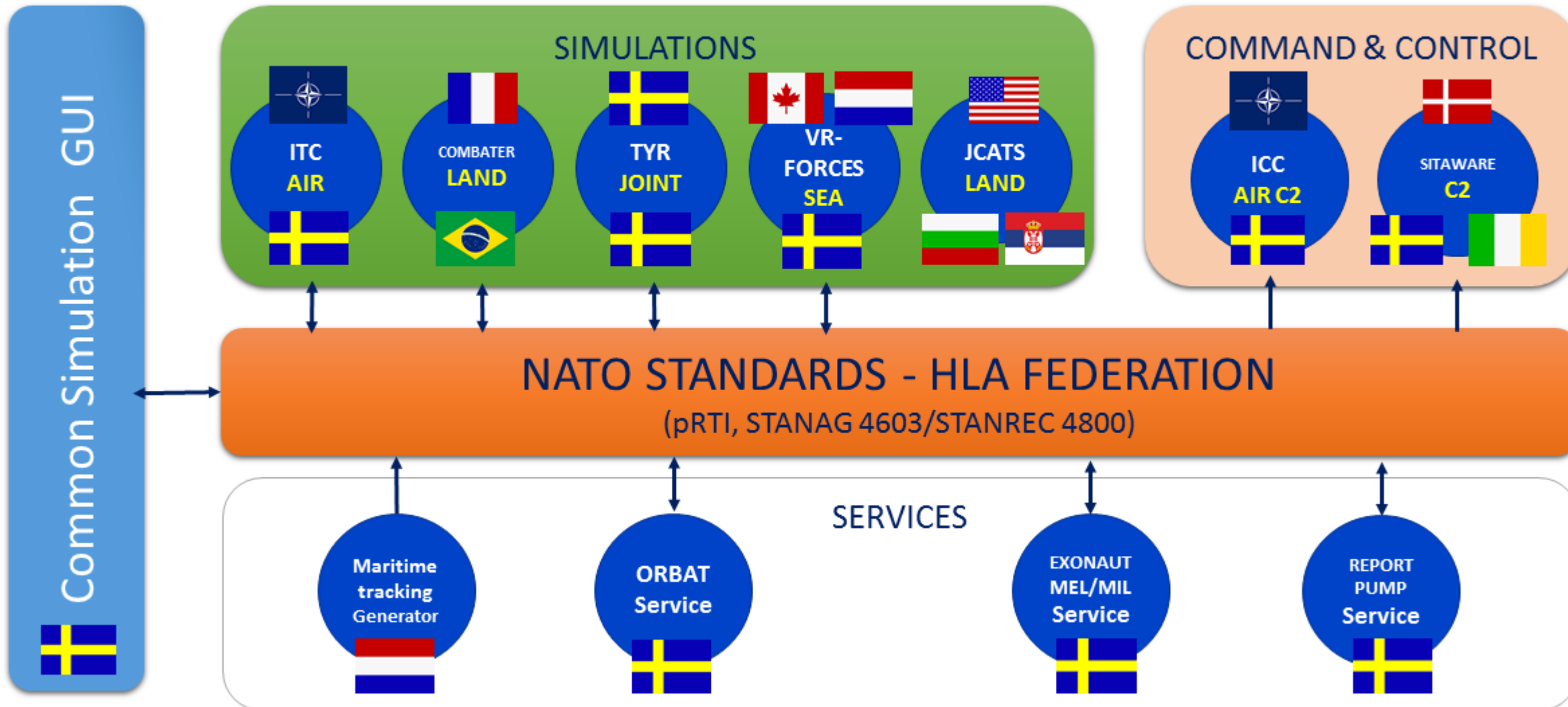

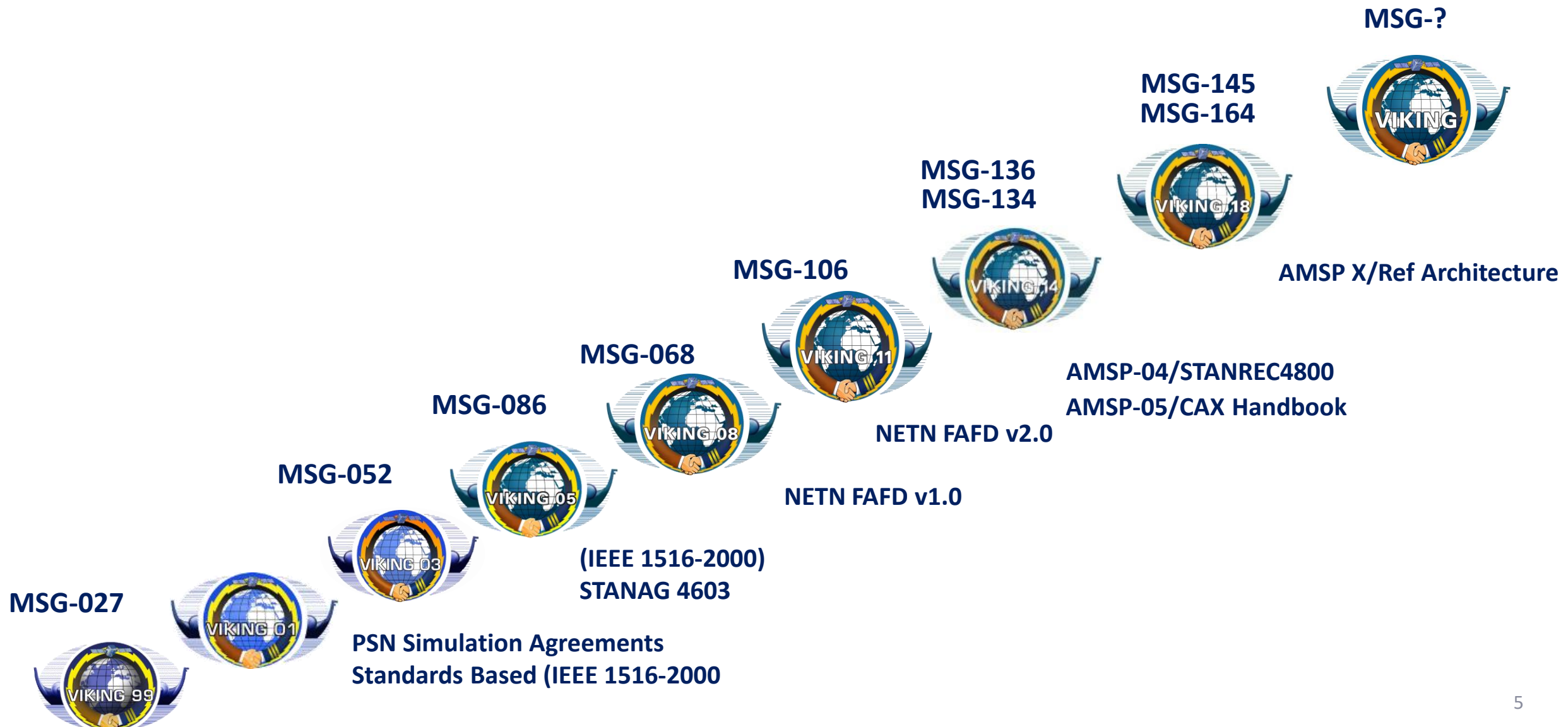
ORBAT – Order of Battle

Evolution of the VIKING - NATO MSG research



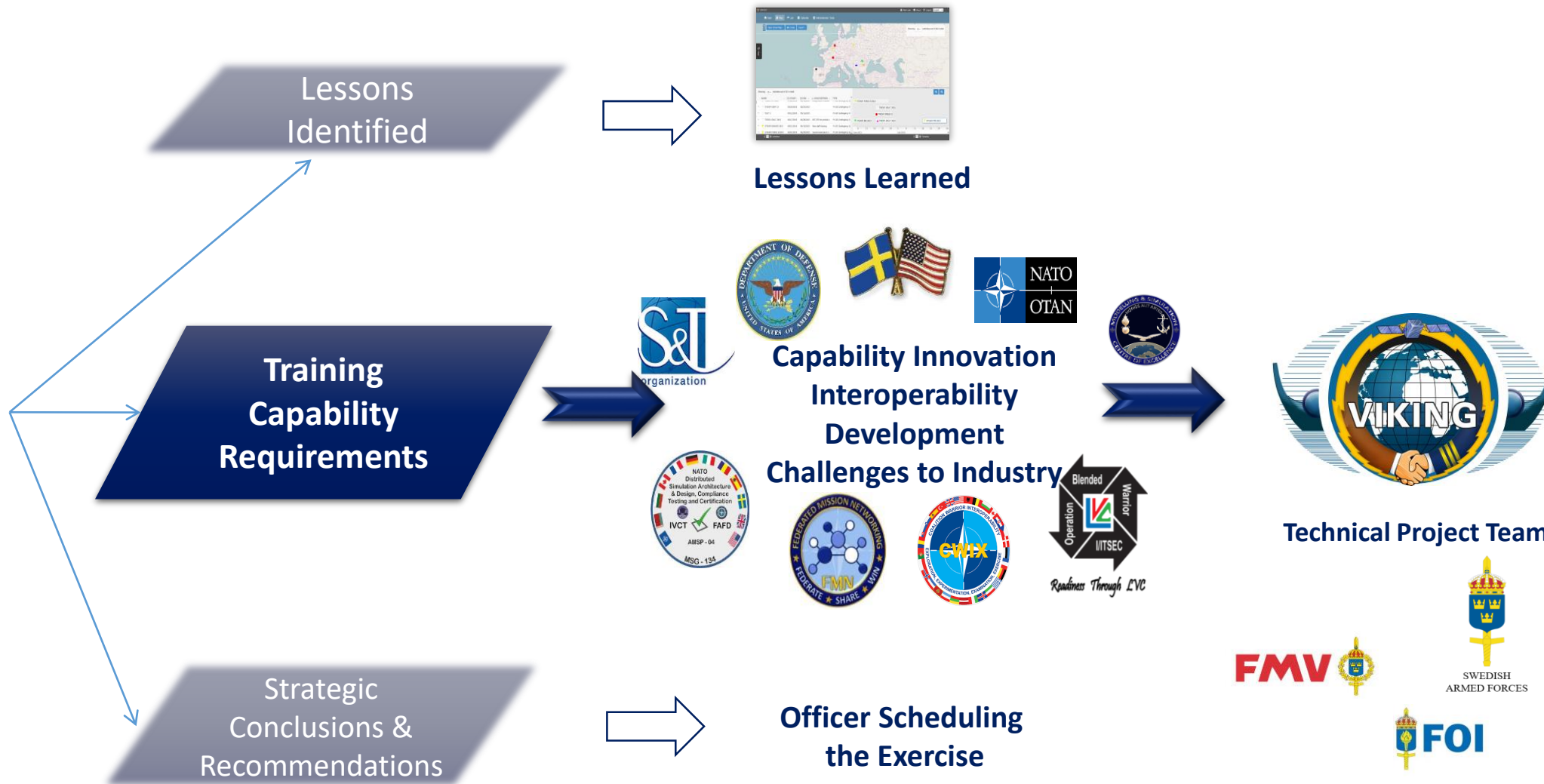


MILITARY TRAINING PROCESS

Training Capability Requirements

DESIRED EFFECTS

- **Efficient start and full training effect already in the beginning of the exercise**
- **Optimization of Exercise Control Activities – cut time**
- **Support of all stages of Training Process**
- **Reduce Exercise Control organization – few train many**
- **Distribute without specific Simulator software – web**
- **Reuse system design**
- **Increase the ability to operate within the information arena**
