








Combat Training Centers

- Army training instrumentation captures all aspects of unit training.
- ✓ Live training not using live or real ammunition.
- Army vehicles, to include aircraft, and all soldiers and weapons systems can be fitted with a sort of 'laser-tag' training system called the Multiple Integrated Laser Engagement System or MILES.
- ✓ It uses lasers and blank cartridges to simulate actual battle.
- ✓ An Instrumentation System is used to "keep score" of the battle.




