Overview

These are accompanied by a range of activities to reinforce key learning points.

- Distinguishing concerning pain from common back pain in patients
- Effectively monitor patients who have been diagnosed with MGUS
- Confidently assess the need for referral in accordance with NICE NG12 guidelines
