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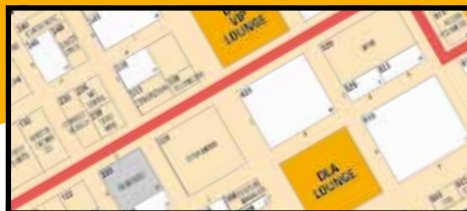

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QUIS CUSTODIET IPSOS CUSTODES?

DURING a time of mooted efficiencies in practice and transition to more modern preventive treatment underpinned by improved transparency in every aspect of dentistry, we find forums being scorched by ranting debate and every MP in reach getting ear-wigged by angry and upset dentists. Of course there is only one subject that could possibly provoke such a reaction while also exciting the expenditure of so much energy – and that is money.



The GDC is currently consulting with all its registrants – dentists and dental care professionals (DCPs) – about instigating a 64% increase to its Annual Retention Fee (ARF) for dentists and a 6.7% increase for DCPs. If passed the increased ARF amounts will rise to £945 and £128 respectively in 2015. Bear in

mind the retention fee for registration with the GMC is currently set at £390 with no plans for any such rate review.

This news has stung the British Dental Association (BDA) into legal action. It has called for a judicial review and letters have been exchanged by solicitors. The BDA feels its questions have not been answered properly while the GDC reasons that everything it is doing is clear and above board.

It states that the number of complaints against dentists has risen by 110% and its expenses in dealing with these complaints has resulted in a cumulative surplus of £3.9m, earned during the period 2011-2013, falling to a deficit of £728,000 in 2013. Forecasts predict a deficit of £5.9m in 2014 and an incredible deficit of £12.1m in

2015. Compound these figures together and the GDC, which has general reserves of £15.2m, will be bankrupt by the end of next year.

I suppose DCPs can feel relieved that they are getting away with all this relatively scot free, but are they? Many technicians and nurses feel they are getting very little bang for their buck following enforced registration. Rather than enjoying a more professional standing and respect they feel as if they have been fleeced in order to provide an additional revenue source.

Let's look at the figures.

Out of a total number of 103,206 registrants 62539 are non-dentists, including 6157 technicians and 286 CDTs. Each of those registrants is paying £120 at present so in total are worth over £7.5m to the council. Dentists at the current rate are worth some £23.5m which will climb to something like £38.5m if the proposed rises take place.

Okay, the cost of regulation is going up so the people who cost the most to regulate will have to shoulder the burden and it is mostly dentists who end up facing Fitness to Practice procedures. However, bearing all this in mind, why did the GDC decide to cover the expense of a full page ad in the *Daily Telegraph* last July? An advert which invited patients to complain about their dentists and even advised them about the best way to do it. It seems strange to carp about an overwhelming increase



in complaints while going out of your way to invite more people to do so.

There have also been rumbles about some very suspect activity on behalf of the GDC's police force, the Dental Complaints Service (DCS) but hearsay is not enough.

The GDC holds itself aloof from criticism and rebuke; it insists on CPD without regulating providers, it spends money prosecuting people who are already retired and don't care about registration. What are they doing?

The Latin quote in the banner headline, 'Quis custodiet ipsos custodes?' translates as 'Who watches the watchmen?' Perhaps now is the time to ask, 'Who regulates the regulators?'

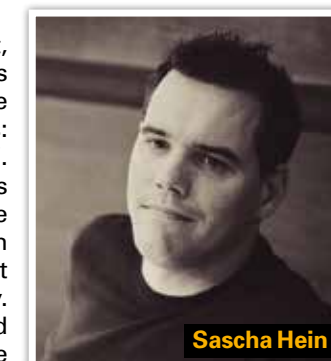

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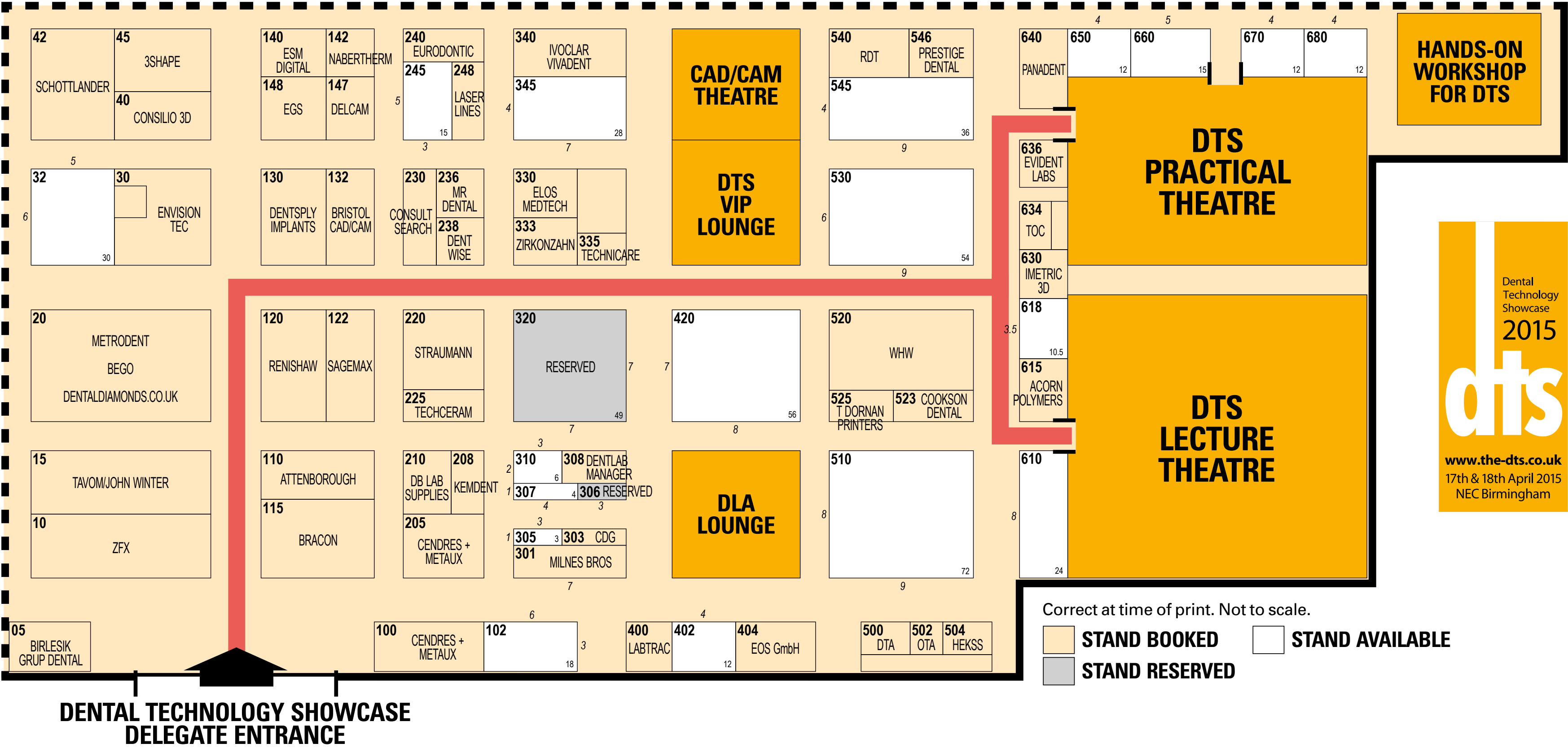

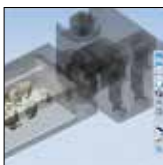
