

DISCOVERING CLINICAL INNOVATIONS AT BDCDS

Education is a key aspect of the British Dental Conference & Dentistry Show (BDCDS). This year, dentists enjoyed an excellent educational programme, comprising of varied clinical topics, delivered by expert speakers. By attending these sessions, delegates were exposed to the latest research, presented by those at the forefront of the dental profession. Whether delegates were looking to expand their knowledge of orthodontics, periodontics, dental implantology, restorative dentistry, or endodontics, there was a wide range of sessions on offer throughout the two-day event.

Options for excellent restorations

BDCDS provides delegates with the opportunity to discover cutting-edge restorative techniques from some of the leading voices in dentistry.

Andrew Chandrapal's session "Direct rehabilitation of anterior teeth: shape, shade, and polishing" provided delegates with a step-by-step process for creating natural-looking anterior restorations. During the session, which was popular amongst delegates, he described a workflow which is versatile, and applicable to a wide range of cases. This included shade matching, creating a natural shape using composite dentine and enamel, with a focus on the best methods for finishing and polishing, and the importance of creating irregularities for natural-looking outcomes.

Eleanor McDonell attended the session, she said:

"It was brilliant, and the information is useful and applicable to my work. I will definitely take what I've learnt back to my practice."

Marco Ferrari's session "Partial crowns for the worn dentition in both anterior and posterior teeth" focused on treating patients with oral parafunction. The lecture was well attended, and explored the treatment options available to patients with tooth wear, and the challenges of bruxism, which has the potential to destroy restorative work. He recommended using temporary

restorations to test the effects longterm, providing patients with a night guard as a preventative measure, and using resin mock-ups and temporary restorations as a "test drive" to boost treatment acceptance. Marco described the importance of adapting restorative treatment to each patient, and discussed a range of potential workflow options when providing laminate veneers.

Paulina Mineva, an associate dentist in attendance, said:

"Marco is an amazing speaker. This lecture has provided me with practical tips and guidance for use in complex cases in my own practice."

Demystifying new imaging technology

Simon Harvey's session "A modern look at CBCT for 2023" aimed to dispel any myths and describe the benefits of using CBCT in clinical cases. Simon described to delegates the realities of CBCT use as an excellent communication tool, allowing patients to provide informed consent.

Dr Ameed K Abdul-Hamid commented:

"The session was fantastic, and the topic was clear, and explained well."





Discovering clinical innovations at BDCDS

A conservative approach to periodontitis treatment

In his session, "Guidelines and Gums: Current concepts in the treatment of periodontitis", Devan Raindi discussed how the S3 treatment guidelines for periodontitis were formed, and how they were adapted by the British Society of Periodontology and Implant Dentistry (BSP) to suit our own healthcare systems. He emphasised the importance of identifying risk factors and how to control them, as well as the benefits of using a nonsurgical technique where possible.

General dentist, Sam Johnson, said:

"Gum disease management is of interest to me, and Devan was a great speaker."

Optimising endodontic results

Expert speakers provided delegates with recommendations for carrying out root canal treatment including boosting longevity, a multidisciplinary approach, and when to refer.

President of the British Endodontic Society, Alyn Morgan, presented his session "Decision making in endodontics" in which he discussed the main issues faced by dentists when carrying out root canal treatment. The lecture proved to be very popular with delegates, and provided a detailed risk assessment approach, encouraging self-reflection to reduce errors and refer cases should they fall outside of the dentist's abilities. Additionally, Alyn discussed techniques which might be used to improve patient assessment, diagnosis, irrigation, restoration, and treatment planning.

Olayimika Osite, a delegate in attendance, said:

"The session was interesting, and Alun has a detailed knowledge base. I learnt some new things, and will definitely take what I learned back to the practice."

Honorary Treasurer of the British Endodontic Society, Daniel Vaz de Souza's session "Root canal treatment outcomes: boosting longevity" focused on maximising the survival of root canal treated teeth. He suggested assessments which might aid diagnosis, and highlighted the importance of thorough root canal disinfection, as well as the risks posed by contaminated equipment, materials, and PPE, as this can impact treatment success.

Principal dentist in attendance, Oril Adtismi, said:

"Daniel is qualified and proficient, and the topic was well covered."

Maryam Chaudhry, a foundation dentist who attended the session, commented:

"The session was engaging and informative. I enjoyed the use of case images to illustrate the discussion."

BDCDS provides dentists with a fantastic opportunity to network and connect with likeminded professionals, attend a wide range of educational sessions, and visit hundreds of trade exhibitors.



BDCDS IS BACK IN BUSINESS

The British Dental Conference & Dentistry Show (BDCDS), is the stand out event bringing in thousands of dental professionals from a wide array of backgrounds. The two-day show connected a variety of disciplines under one roof to undertake the biggest discussions in modern dentistry.

Alongside clinically focused lectures, the scene was set for fundamental conversations about dental business management, mental health, and how to make the most of the entire dental team.

NHS dentistry today

Within the Dental Business Theatre programmed by Practice Plan, a crowd drew close to listen in on a debate around one of the biggest questions facing UK dentistry today, "Is there a future for NHS Dentistry?", led by Zoe Close. The panel provided unmatched insight into the current landscape of NHS dentistry and the issues surrounding it. Shawn Charlwood provided a damning indictment of the government's efforts to recover the crisis of hope around NHS contracts. Likening the proposals made to repairing torn deckchairs on the sinking Titanic, Charlwood was joined by Nigel Jones and Simon Thackeray, who shared their thoughts on the situation at large.

The panel echoed the importance of NHS dentistry alongside private practices in providing care to those that may need it most. The patients at the centre of the issue were of prime concern within the conversation. as Nigel lamented those that may be squeezed out of healthcare that they cannot afford. The group were in agreement that dentists are providing unbelievable care every day, and the profession can be proud of its efforts to be there for patients.

Jane Lelean, a business coach and former principal dentist, said of the

"It was a great presentation, both balanced and professional. It importantly and rightly put the patient's best interests first, making the difference between those than 'can't' and 'won't' access care."

Recession

Kevin Rose offered up an engaging session on "How to survive a recession". where he shared with delegates his keys to building lasting long-term relationships with patients, and developing a successful practice. Kevin delved into the importance of building a reliable and kind reputation that can spread effectively through word of mouth, rather than focusing primarily on generic website taglines. He emphasised the importance of language and routines that feel personalised for a patient, and signified the need for emotional care rather than a digital excess.

Dentist Usman Waheed was full of praise for Kevin, as he noted:

"The speaker was very good and engaging. His content was interesting, and has added to a really enjoyable

Mental Health

The personal side of business leadership was of heavy consideration, as the question "How can I keep myself mentally fit?" was posed to a panel led by Les Jones. The mounting anxieties surrounding dentists and their teams were highlighted, with an urge help destigmatise mental health struggles within the profession. Laura Hannon called for dental professionals to reach out to those around them when they notice someone struggling, and be a friend as well as a supportive colleague.

Liz Storis, an NHS psychotherapist and former dental hygienist and therapist, thought the panel was excellent as she said:

"The talk was really interesting and important. It's a topic nobody really wants to talk about. A lot of dentists are isolated, and have so many balls in the air to worry about, from patients to litigation. Having this discussion is completely necessary."

Leading a team

One of the toughest tasks for a dental professional can be making the most of their collective team's potential. Experienced dentist Bhavna Doshi provided an insight into the importance of building a positive team culture in her talk "Building a quality team", in the BAPD Private Dentistry Theatre. Bhavna encouraged individuals to be seen as leaders in their own areas, rather than employees, empowering them to achieve objectives in working towards a collective vision and in turn growing a practice.

With everchanging business requirements for practices, BDCDS provided an opportunity for delegates to understand the latest developments. At the Compliance Clinic, sponsored by Apolline, Patricia Langley detailed the CQC's evolving approach to inspections and regulations, instilling confidence in delegates on how to pass with flying colours. The importance of acting upon mistakes and assessing patient feedback regularly was of note for Pat, who discussed compliance as a shared team effort.

Dental hygienist Gail Braine found the session especially helpful, as she said:

"The talk was really direct and informative. It's good to brush up and take this knowledge into my own

practice to implement. I don't love learning online, so having these talks in person and speaking to a wide variety of new people is brilliant. I'm reallu learning a lot!"

Dr Naveed Ahmad of Pak Smile Dental Clinic celebrated the importance of the show as he said:





DTS 2023 - IT'S LIKE WE NEVER LEFT

All businesses big and small have been impacted in recent years due to a muriad of reasons. This year's Dental Technology Showcase (DTS) had much to offer dental technicians in the way of guidance, information, support and camaraderie.

In the OTA Seminars & Den-tech Forum, Ashley Byrne, Managing Director of Burnes Dental Laboratory, presented his lecture. "21st Centuru dental technology: The art of running a modern lab". DEN-TECH ATTEND DTS 2023 AS OFFICIAL **CHARITY PARTNER**



Dental charity Den-Tech partnered with Dental Technology Showcase (DTS) as the official charity partner for 2023, bringing delegates at this year's show the brand-new Den-Tech Forum. Founded in 2017 by dental technicians Andrea Johnson and Andrew Sinclair, Den-Tech was set up in order to provide quality dental technology services to the most vulnerable. Today, Den-Tech collaborates with a number of other charities such as the Southampton Veterans Trust and SUDTA (Stand Up to Domestic Abuse) to help reconstruct the teeth of those in need.

The agenda for the Den-Tech Forum was curated by Den-Tech chairperson Andrea Johnson to support dental technicians in their continuing professional development, but also to show how dental professionals can make a real difference through their dentistry. Featuring a two-day lecture programme with topics ranging from advice on running a 21st century dental lab, to domestic abuse awareness in dentistry, attendees came away with practical tips to help their work as dental technicians, and also a sense of how dental professionals can play a part in tackling important issues in today's society.

One of the lectures was delivered by Rachel Williams, founder of SUDTA, who used her speaking session to raise awareness both about domestic abuse, and about the work that she has been doing with Den-Tech over the past 18 months to help domestic abuse victims get their teeth restored. Reflecting on her time at the event, Rachel said, "Today I've been talking about domestic abuse and violence because it's a pandemic. It's certainly an epidemic here in the UK. Together with Den-Tech, we're setting up a national register, IMTAS (It's more than a smile) to help vulnerable victims of domestic abuse and violence that need emergency dental treatment. It allows pro-bono dentists, lab technicians and dental nurses to sign

up so that if there's someone in their area that needs that treatment asap. they can help."

As well as unveiling the new IMTAS system and encouraging delegates to get involved, Rachel also used her speaking session to talk about her own experience of domestic abuse and how dental professionals can recognise the signs. "Hopefully the main takeaway for the audience today is to be observant of fellow colleagues and be observant of patients that come through the door. Look for those signs of abuse. Ask those questions because domestic abuse only thrives in the darkness, so we've got to shine the light on it."

Another lecture in the Den-Tech Forum was given by Edward Mapley, lecturer in dental technology at Cardiff Metropolitan University. Edward's talk, "Dental devices for those experiencing homelessness", covered some of the



barriers that prevent homeless people from receiving dental treatment, such as high levels of dental anxiety and difficulty in accessing dental services, as well as outlining some possible solutions, such as a more

interdisciplinary approach and a closer working relationship between social services and health services.

Speaking about his time at DTS, Edward said, "It was another enjoyable Dental Technology Showcase. There is nothing else quite like it in the UK for dental technicians. 
