How to get to the Singapore Vet Show

By Plane

Singapore's **Changi Airport** is the main international gateway to the city, serving over 100 airlines that operate flights to around 400 cities across 100 countries and territories.



With approximately 7,200 flights taking off or landing each week. The airport is just a 20-minute drive from Suntec Singapore, making it highly accessible for visitors. From here there are multiple transportation options including the MRT, taxis, and airport shuttles.

By Train

Start your journey from your nearest MRT station. You can take either the **Circle Line (CCL)** or the **Downtown Line (DTL)** to get to Suntec Singapore.



The closest MRT stations to **Suntec Singapore Convention & Exhibition Centre** are:

- Promenade MRT Station (CC4/DT15): Take Exit C, walk through Suntec City Mall, and follow the signs to the convention centre.
- Esplanade MRT Station (CC3): This station is about a 3-minute walk from Suntec Singapore Convention Centre.

Whichever station you arrive to, the walk to the Suntec Singapore Convention Centre is well signposted, making it easy to follow.



By Car

Suntec Singapore has an extensive parking facility in the **Suntec City Mall** area, with multiple entrances:

- The main entrance for parking is via Temasek Boulevard or Raffles Boulevard.
- Look for Suntec City Mall parking, which is directly connected to the Convention Centre.

You can use a GPS or maps app like Google Maps, Apple Maps, or Waze to guide you to **Suntec Singapore Convention & Exhibition Centre**. Simply input **"Suntec Singapore Convention & Exhibition Centre"** or the address **1 Raffles Boulevard, Suntec City** as your destination for accurate directions.

DO YOU NEED A VISA?

You may be required to obtain a valid visa when travelling to Singapore. Here's a few countries that are required: Algeria, Belarus, Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Egypt, India, Jordan, Lebanon, Morocco, Nigeria, Pakistan, Syria, Tunisia, Ukraine.

If you're traveling from the following countries, you **do not** need a visa to enter Singapore: China, Australia, Malaysia, Indonesia, Philippines, and Hong Kong. However, please verify the details, as some countries offer exemption for stays of up to 30 days only.

How to get to the Singapore Vet Show



By Taxi

Alight at the driveway in front of The Big Picture on Level 1 for quick access to our Centre. Use taxi app's <u>Grab</u> or <u>TADA</u> to plan your journey. Alternatively, you can hail a taxi



from designated taxi stands at various locations, such as hotels, shopping malls, or public transport stations.

By Bus

Choose from various bus services that drop off at multiple stops near the Centre. We recommend using <u>Singabus</u> or <u>Citymapper</u> to plan your route.

By Shuttle Bus

The Changi Airport Shuttle service is available, and it offers drop-offs at major hotels and convention centers, including Suntec Singapore. The shuttle bus from Changi Airport

runs to city centre every 15 min during peak hour and every 30 min during off-peak 24/7.

Accommodation

Singapore Vet has partnered with a number of accommodations that are just a short walk away from our event venue - Suntec Singapore, so you can have peace of mind and a comfortable stay during the event.

EXTRA TIPS

Walking Around:

Singapore is easy to explore on foot - Especially in central areas like Marina Bay and Orchard.

Stay shaded when possible - Bring an umbrella for sun or sudden rain.

Explore by Water:

Try a bumboat ride along the Singapore River - Great for sightseeing.

Use the Sentosa Express or cable car - Fun ways to reach Sentosa Island.

General Tips

The whole city is well signposted - so navigation is easy.

Singapore is safe and clean - But be aware of rules (no eating/ drinking on public transport, etc.).

Stay hydrated – It's hot and humid, so carry water and dress light.

Language

While English is the main language, Malay, Mandarin, and Tamil are also official languages. Most locals are bilingual.



. Currency

The Singapore Dollar (SGD) is used. Credit cards are widely accepted, but

it's advisable to carry cash for hawker centers and small shops.

Weather

The weather in October tends to be warm and humid, with occasional rain showers, typical of Singapore's

tropical climate. Average temperature: 25°C to 31°C (77°F to 88°F).

Public transport

Public transport in Singapore is renowned for its efficiency,

affordability, and cleanliness. The MRT is the most popular option, covering key attractions, neighborhoods, and business areas across the city.

Tipping

Tipping is not customary, as service charges are typically included in bills.



Queuing

Singaporeans take queuing seriously; always stand in line orderly.
