

Baby Nido (Spanish for "nest"): Infants

Smiles, cries, coos, and babbles flood the Baby Nido classroom with expression—a classroom that is intentionally designed to offer a homelike environment that will nurture and soothe.

Nido

Our Nido program helps toddlers develop their expressive language skills, experience empathy, engage in pretend-play, and practice social roles as they navigate their first relationships and begin to create their own identities.





Class of the Twos

In this class, we offer opportunities for children to encounter challenges that promote individual identity and collaborative play. In addition to emotional growth, the physical growth of fine motor skills provides our Two's with greater manipulative control.

Class of the Threes

At this stage of development, children continue to express themselves but with greater depth and precision. We encourage the development of these emergent literacy skills by awakening their affinity for and interest in written communication.

Class of the Fours

Complex thinking, for children in this class, becomes even more visible. As they give further shape to their ideas, they do so by utilizing technology, graphics, written communication, and more.

Kindergarten

At this age, children display an awareness of their thought processes and begin understanding how to make plans, execute those plans, and reflect on their results. Their self-confidence and management skills go hand-in-hand with their growing academic capabilities, leading to a meaningful year in preparation for elementary school.

Our Ateliers (French for "art studio" or "workshop") welcome children to an inspiring array of natural and human-made materials that are visible and available.

Individually or in small groups, our children encounter experiences with the various media that progressively support all their languages of expression. The Atelier's clay, paper, fabric, wire, light, beads, shells, leaves, wood, and other materials offer the children endless possibilities in early exploration of the visual arts.

WHAT IS REGGIO EMILIA?

The Reggio Emilia Approach, which originated in a region of Italy after World War II, employs a holistic, multisensory method to learning and growth in which children always learn by doing. It requires children to have some control over the direction of their learning—through the experiences of touching, moving, seeing, listening, hearing, experimenting, investigating, and ultimately making sense of themselves and the wider world they inhabit. As a result, the Reggio approach is considered to support "the finest early learning schools in the world."
