To order at the counter of the small orange-and-white building on Liliha Street in the bustling Kalihi neighborhood of Honolulu is the start of a journey into the cuisine that has become one of the biggest things out of Hawai'i since surfing.

This Hawai'i landmark is the birthplace of L & L Hawaiian Barbecue, the restaurant franchise that has popularized the growing Asian-fusion cuisine of the plate lunch.

In the 60's, L & L founders Eddie Flores, Jr. and Johnson Kam and their families immigrated to the United States in search of a better life through the pursuit of the American Dream.

In 1976, Flores and Kam partnered to found L & L Drive-Inn®, from the original L & L restaurant and dairy, which opened in 1952. The eatery was a popular place that served generously portioned plate-lunches to hungry area workers. They later coined the term Hawaiian Barbecue® and the trade names L & L Hawaiian Barbecue® and

Today, with over 200 locations in 15 states and Japan, L & L is the largest Hawaiian-inspired restaurant chain in the world, and one of the largest serving Asian-American cuisine. Each L & L restaurant serves

authentic island-cuisine, a fusion of the flavors brought to Hawai'i by its diverse population of Chinese, Japanese, Native-Hawaiian, Filipino, Portuguese, and Korean descent and even descendants of missionaries from New England.

What is a Plate Lunch?

Plate lunch - also known as "the state food of Hawai'i" - dates back to the 1880s, when immigrant wage laborers in Hawaiian sugar plantations and pineapple fields brought rice and other leftovers for lunch in compartmentalized tins or bento boxes. Lunches were often shared, resulting in a harmonious mix of home recipes from across the globe. This blend of cuisines formed a "local food" style that became the hallmark of Hawai'i. In the 1930s, lunch wagons began serving mixed-style food on compartmentalized paper plates, starting the traditional "plate lunch" we know today.
