14 year old guest fell from ride whilst in motion. CCTV showed he sat the seat first having clipped through the over shoulder restraint during the descend phase (as it was slowing) of the ride cycle.

- The ride did not experience a mechanical or electrical failure.
- Prior to the incident, the seat harness proximity sensor (and interlock) was set within normal restraint operating range (around a 3 inch gap).
- However, prior to the immediate operation of the ride in this case, the seat harness proximity sensor was manually loosened, adjusted, and repositioned to create a restraint operating range of around 7 inches.
- The guest was not secured properly in the seat due to an mis-adjustment of the seat proximity sensor (interlock).

This adjustment still allowed both sensor lights to illuminate on the control panel. Improperly satisfying the ride's electronic safety mechanism allowing the ride to commence even though the ride was unsafe and out of safety parameter.

**Preventative actions**

- Special attention to harness-to-seat gap within the design and operation. Critical to maintain minimum gap as stated within the relevant BS, EN, ASTM and ISO standards.
- Ergonomic assessment of safety critical design features to be accommodating of rider characteristics – weight, height etc.
- Prohibiting adjustment of safety-critical criteria' settings during the ride operation.
- Management oversight of Safety Critical Rules which were seemingly breached.
- Operator Competency – Trained, experienced and correct attitude for safety.
- Strict Rules – regarding height and weight limits and adaptation for customers which must be prohibited.
- A full review of the ride's design safety operation, restraint mechanisms and history, as part of an annual formal Statutory Testing and Inspection programme.
- Primary, secondary and tertiary safety restraints and safety systems working together to ensure correct engineering control and layers of redundancy in the event a system fails or is over-ridden.
- Safe maintenance of rides – OSHA and in-service protocols performed by competent engineers who have a thorough understanding of the safety controls specific to the equipment they are working on.

The Lessons Learnt document is designed to promote shared learnings and best practice to improve safety within the L&E industry from incidents. This is a summary document using publicly available facts. This document does not constitute a full investigation report. Key Learnings and Preventative actions are generic in their nature and are not a comprehensive list of outcomes from the specific incident. They are offered by the MENALAC HSE Committee as key observations and suggested preventative actions to be used at the discretion of the user.

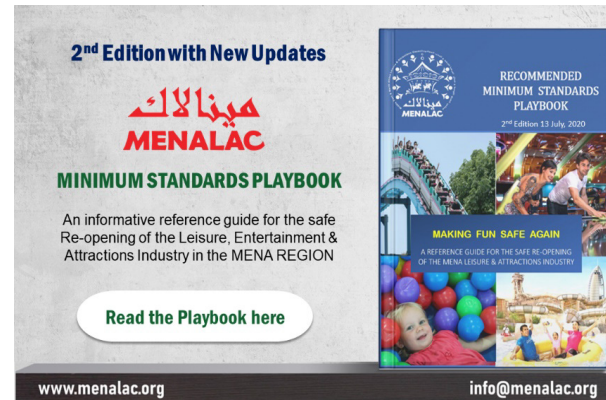
