Generate. **Connect** the AFU demand with IC supply through the sourcing of additional donations. Coordinate, with SAG-U and AFU, the **capability integration, movement** into UKR and its fielding into the AFU operational design.

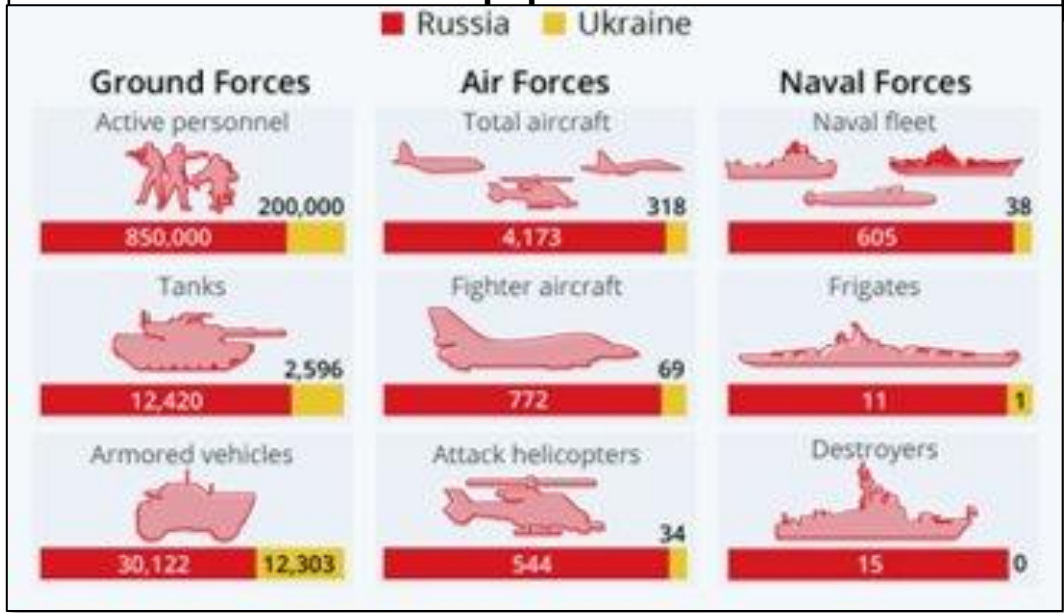

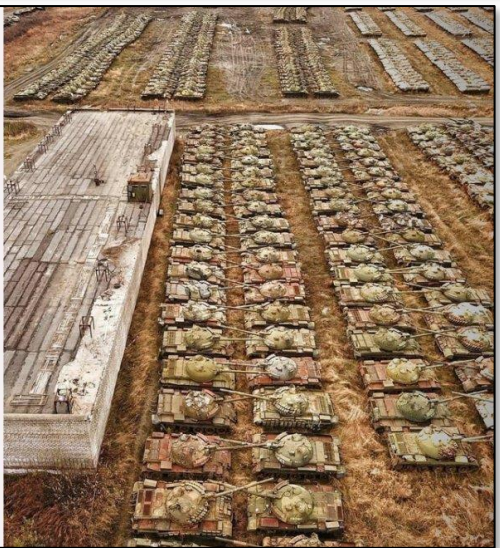
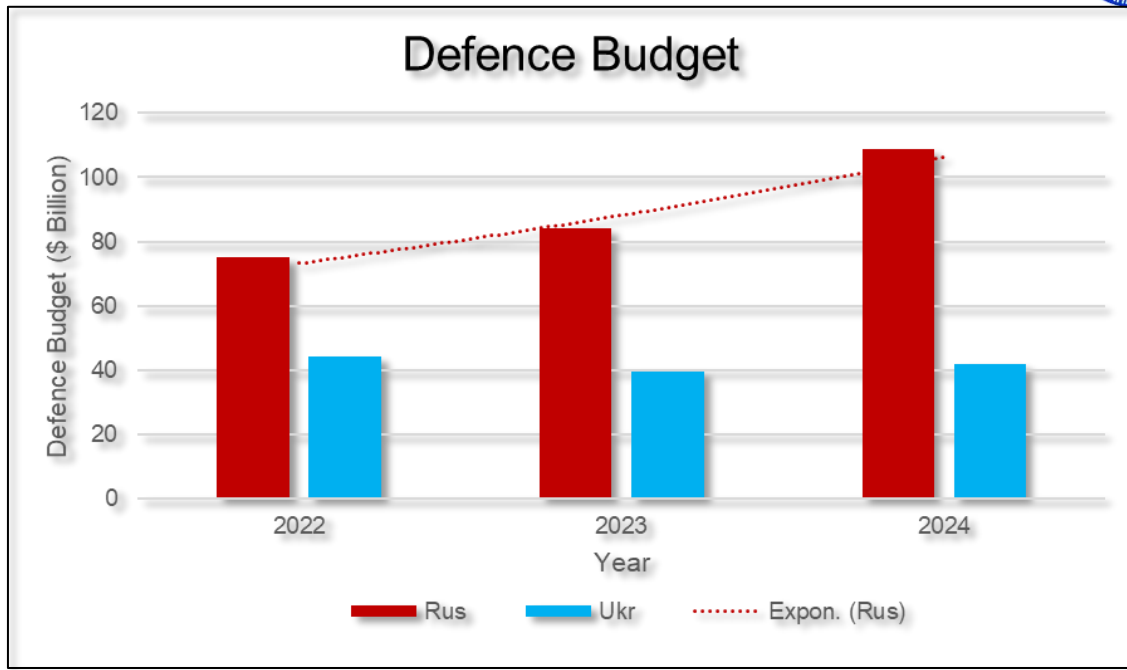

Initial Equipment 2022

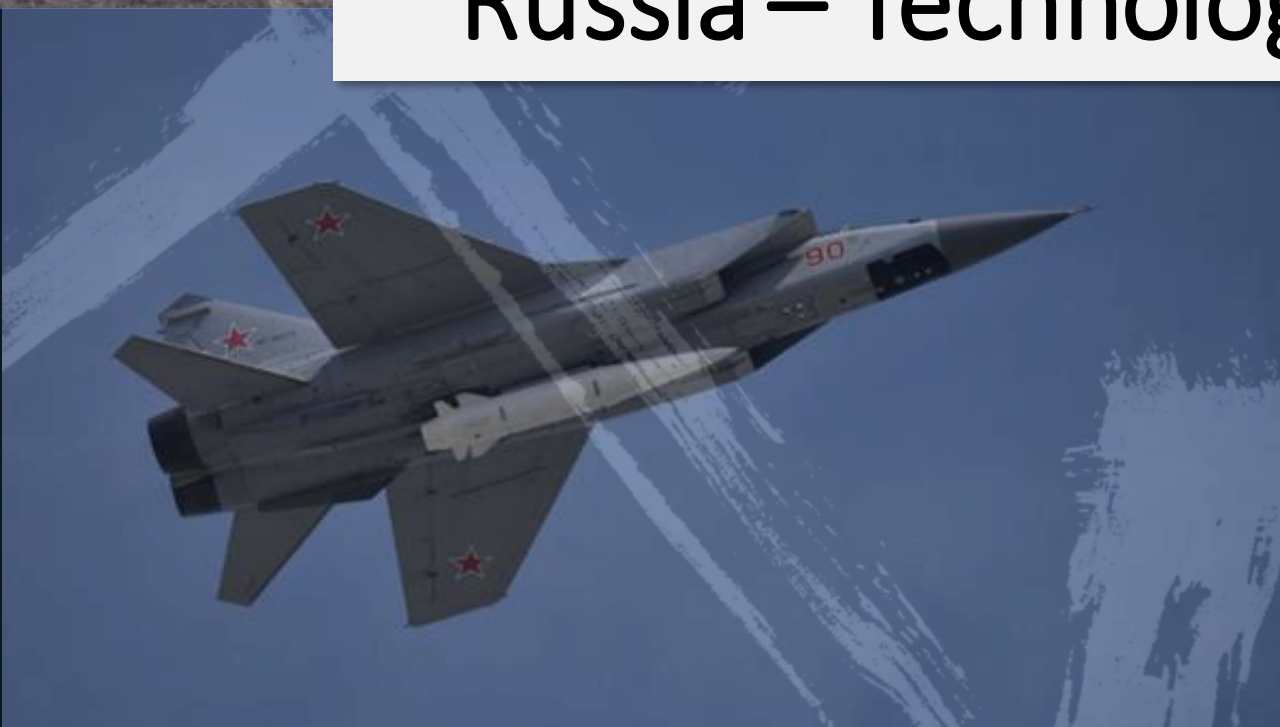


Defence Budget

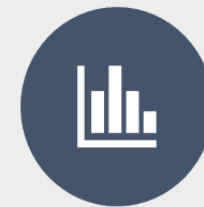

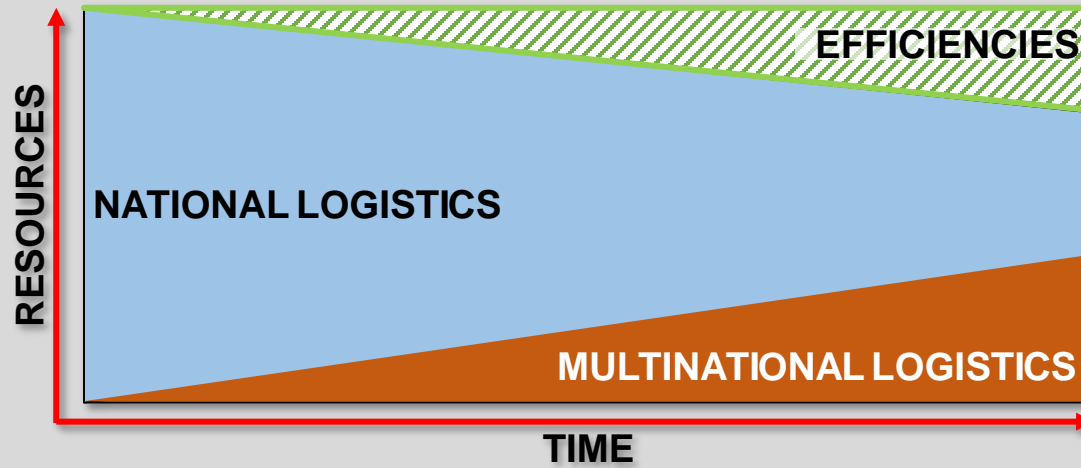

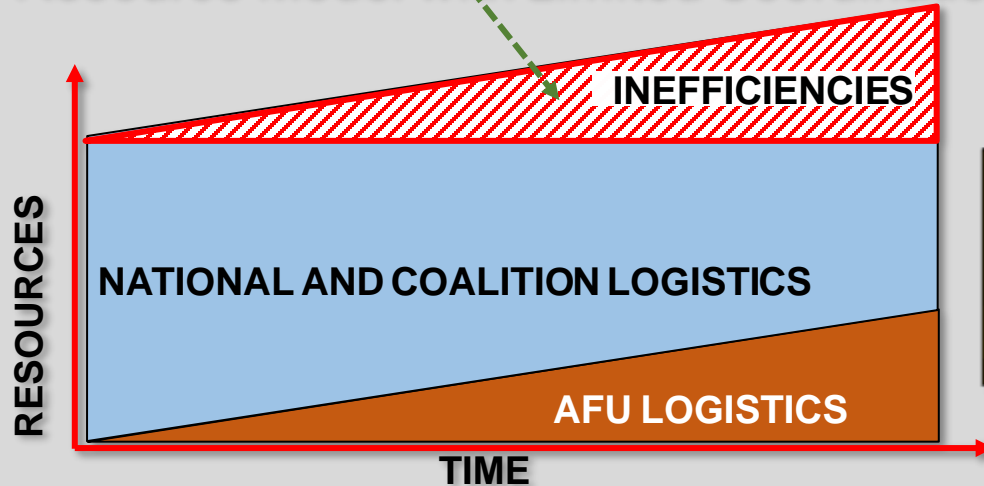
