



HYPER-COMPETITIVE

- A high number of relevant political-strategic actors, increasingly capable, assertive, and able to influence international dynamics
- A "thirst" for resources
- A military dimension that is becoming a primary factor in competitive dynamics
- Competition for control of technology verticals and dominance in disruptive sectors
- The assertion and consolidation of multi-domain as a common element in current conflicts and presumably future ones.
- The presence of private entities actively operating in areas previously reserved for Defense, such as communications and satellite imagery, or access to Space.
- Competition for Critical Raw Materials (CRM)



It is necessary to continue seeking renewed synergy between the Military And Industry




