





The Norwegian Total Defense System



The NATO JLSG

- JLSG is the key means by which NATO delivers multinational logistic support for operations
- JLSG is designed to support rapidly deployable forces and flexible C2 structures
- JLSG is scalable, adaptable and task organized to match the mission
- JLSG is a Component Command equivalent, executing C2 over operational/tactical level logistic units.





To enable the <u>responsive deployment and sustainment of NATO forces</u> in order to support the Joint Task Force's operations, missions and activities. BI-SC NCS-Adaptation (2018)

THE MISSION OF JLSG HQ IS TO:

- Command, control & coordinate assigned units for execution JTF operational plan
- Enable Reception Staging and Onward Movement (RSOM) and Rearward Movement Staging and Dispatch (RMSD)
- Provide 3rd line of theatre logistic support in the JOA







Executive summary

Objectives

- Development of standing commercial operational logistics capabilities within NSPA-OLSP that could augment the Nordic Nations' Host Nation Support (HNS) commitments for complex multinational endeavors in the Arctic.
- Once established, these capabilities could be extended to continental Europe / 'globally' for use by all OLSP Member Nations (Allies + Partners).

Scope

- Three-phase implementation:
 - Phase-1: Deployable Camp Support / Supply Services (DCSS), Auxilliary Camp Services (AUX)
 - Phase-2: Convoy Support Centers (CSC)
 - Phase-3: Camp Security Services (CSS)
- Establishment of a HNS Augmentation (HNS-A) Project Group (PG) sponsored and led by Norway.

Timeline

- Apr 2024: Norway will announce sponsorship of the HNS-A PG during the 30th OLSP Committee Meeting.
- Mid-2024: Formal establishment of the HNS-A PG.
- Q4-2027: FOC of the entire HNS-A capability (Phase-1, Phase-2, Phase-3).
