





SECURITY SITUATION

ASSESSIMENT

- BiH invited to start EU accession negotiations
- Population is against any conflict
- Modernization but no militarization of the police
- SIPA is reliable and collaborates with EUROPOL
- AFBiH development ongoing
 - DCB in cooperation with NHQSa
 - Training & EX with EUFOR

The main concern in BiH is still on the **political slope** (versus security slope). No current indications for a direct/specific threat to the security situation,

but a change of paradigm (EU accession).

Issues of concern

- Municipality elections -> diverging political interests
- Partially or unachieved EU joining conditions
- Reform Agenda for receiving funds from Western Balkans
 Growth Plan not finalized
- HR using Bonn Powers
- The RS pursues a policy aimed at reaffirming its position IOT protect its constitutional rights and freedom of action in the context of EU accession
- Threats of aggression before the Municipal Election
- Economic difficulties
- AFBiH faces financial, manning and equipment challenges





MISSION FRAMEWORK

- **24 TCNs** (18 EU-members, 6 non-EU)
- Berlin +
- Mandate in accordance with Dayton Peace Agreement

 - Non-executive mandate □ Training and EX with AFBiH □ EUFOR
- EUFOR continues to train with AFBIH
- Politics (BXL) vs. Operational (OHQ) vs. Tactical / execution (BiH) level
- Different chains of command
 - Mons
 - Naples
- LEAs responsible for SASE and primary partners to EUFOR





MISSION AND TASKS

Operation Althea, under the authority of the UNSC, and in line with its mandate, will **support the Authorities of BiH** effort to maintain Safe And Secure **Environment** (SASE) in order to contribute to the stability of the country.

SR2023

- Reserve forces to be fully manned and maintained at all times.
- EUFOR maintain and strengthen as needed – its communication strategy.


- <u>Develop</u>, maintain and share **Awareness and** Information
- 2. <u>Contribute</u> to the Operation's **deterrence** effect
- Support **BiH authorities** in:
 - Disposing surplus Ammunition Weapons and Explosives (AWE), and coordinates IC support
 - Humanitarian demining
 - Interoperability development, including training opportunities, of AFBiH within means and capabilities
- 4. Supporting the Deployment of Reserve Forces in Reception, Staging, Onward Movement and Integration (RSOMI) processes, as required





SUMMARY

- EUFOR is still required effects crucial & its presence determinant
 - EUFOR part of EU's Integrated Approach
- Peacekeeping mission (vs territorial defence) with tasks adapted to the situation
 - LEAs EUFOR's main partner
 - Projecting deterrence and demonstrating presence
 - Special supporting tasks (AWE disposal, de-mining, monitoring DIF)
 - Distinguished role for LOTs
- Available forces are adequate and deterrent under the current circumstances
 - Strong support from troop contributing nations
- Readiness and training of reserve forces essentiat
