



Urbanisation is accelerating







Alternative training media are therefore required











Lethality training

- Very short ranges (50-75m)
- Moving, fleeting targets
- Elevated and depressed angles of fire (3D)


Sustainment training

- Deception (C2D2)















OPTIMISING URBAN TRAINING TO DEFEAT OUR ENEMIES

THE URBAN COMMANDMENTS

- Adapt your Capability to the Environment.

 Exploit your strengths and mitigate your weaknesses but avoiding urban isn't an option you must have an effect.
- Use the Terrain. It provides cover, manoeuvre and deception opportunities.
- 3 Situational Awareness is a Struggle. Expect to be uncomfortable, fight for information, react to change.
- 4 Command and Control is Difficult. Command forward; give and receive mission command freely.
- **Expect a Close Fight.** Routine engagements are at 30-100 metres. The enemy will be closer.

- Armour has a Vital Role. In defence or attack, armour is a force multiplier.
- 7 Fires Enable Manoeuvre. Fires still have a key role, but the complex terrain and higher collateral damage require more planning.
- 8 Civilians are Always Present. Plan for them, don't just react. Don't expect rational behaviour.
- **Everything takes Longer.** Manoeuvre, CASEVAC and resupply will take up to eight times longer than in the rural.
- 10 Logistics Planning takes Longer. If your log and med planning begin at H-Hour, you've already lost. Move everything closer to the point of need.
