



NATO'S CBRN DEFENCE CONCEPT

Crosscutting Functions

- "...disciplines that converge with CBRN defence throughout all CBRN defence Lines of Effort...they contribute to strengthening the deterrence and defence posture of the Alliance."
- "...support NATO to fulfil its two CBRN defence core principles and commitments."

IMPORTANCE OF CLIMATE CONSIDERATIONS

- ✓ Conflict, fragility and instability in Africa and the Middle East directly affect our security and the security of our partners... These are aggravated by the impact of climate change, fragile institutions, health emergencies and food insecurity. (NATO 2022 Strategic Concept)
- ✓ Climate change is a defining challenge of our time...Our forces need to operate in more extreme climate conditions, and our militaries are more frequently called upon to assist in disaster relief. (NATO 2022 Strategic Concept)

✓ Changes in operating conditions due to climate change will affect the types of CBRN challenges that NATO forces face and the capabilities required to overcome them... the Alliance will incorporate climate change considerations into its work, to enhance CBRN defence capabilities and the resilience of the Nations. (MC 0603 (draft))

IMPORTANCE OF CLIMATE CONSIDERATIONS

Education and Training Considerations

- ✓ CBRN related ETEE should incorporate and reflect ... changes in the threat environment and the adaptation of specific CBRN defence capabilities. (MC 0603)
- ✓ Climate. Consider impact of climate on agent persistency and performance degradation of personnel. (ATP-3.8.1, VOL I)


Gender perspective is defined as the ability to detect if and when men, women, boys and girls are being affected differently by a particular situation due to their gender (MC 0603 (draft))





GENDER CONSIDERATIONS
