- Aviation board 1926

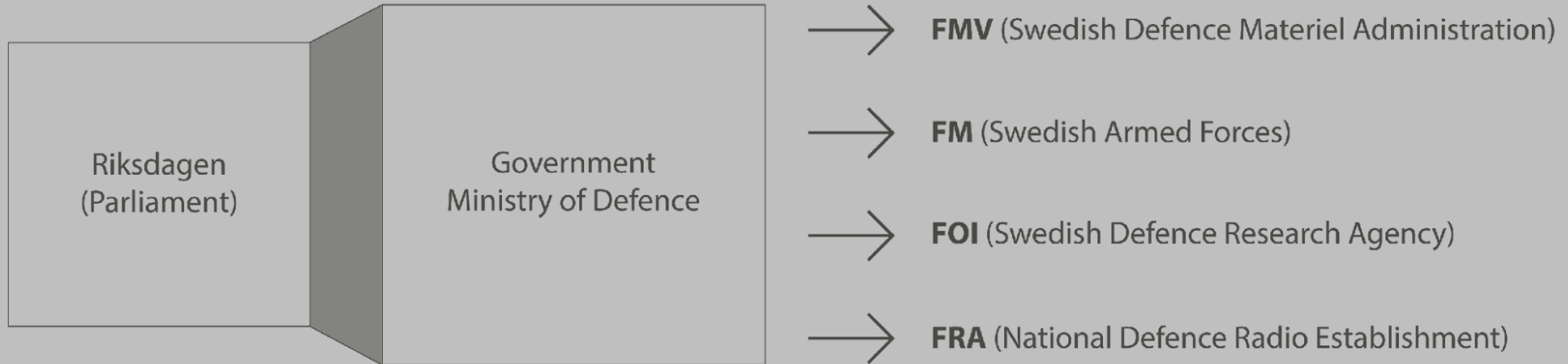

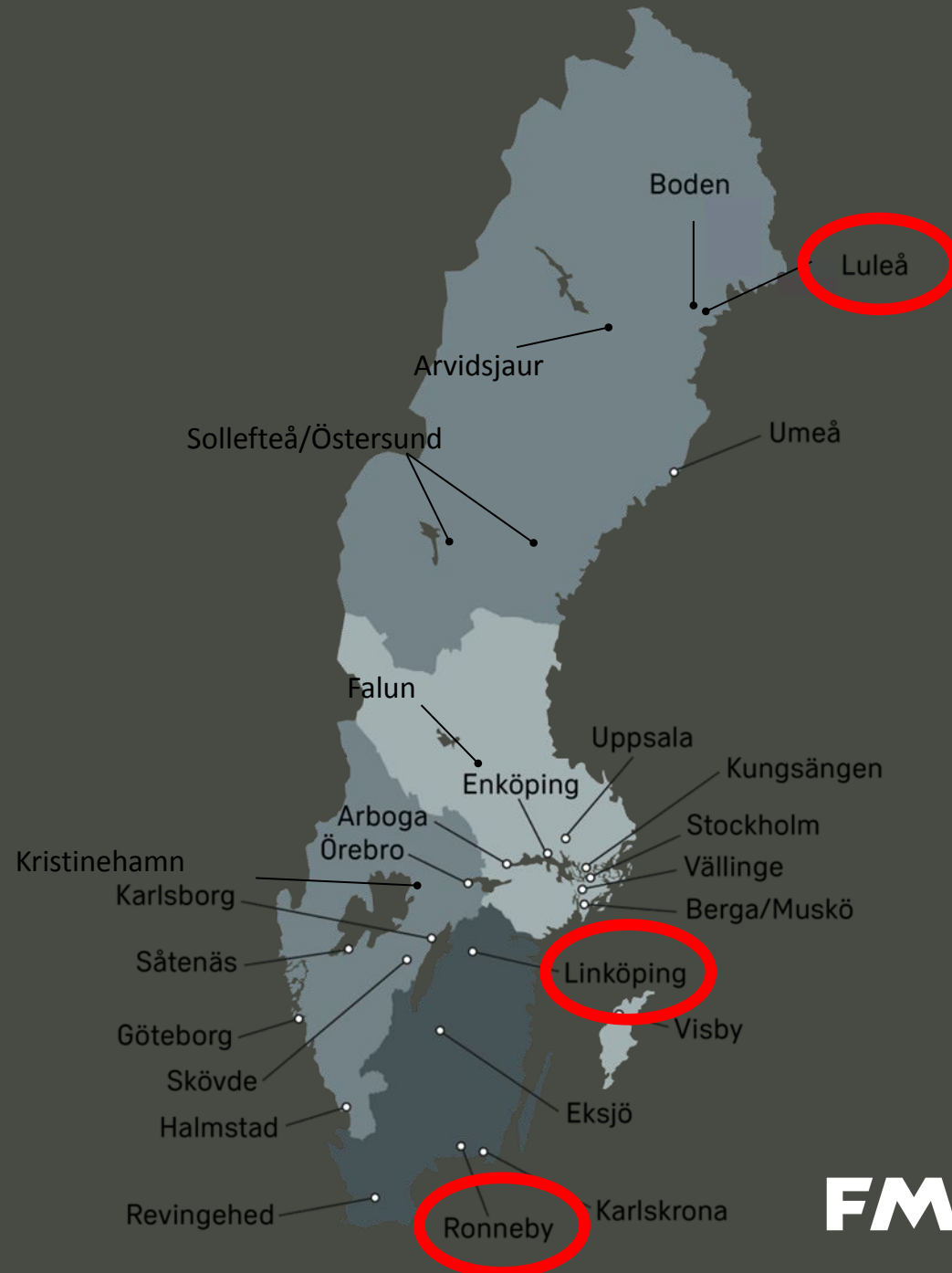

Total Defence Bill 2025-2030, 15th of October

- Military defence receiving more than SEK 170 billion until 2030
- Defence expenditures will reach 2.6 per cent of GDP in 2028
- Substantial reinforcements of the total defence
- Accelerating the pace of military production is prioritized
