After more than a decade of success the Multinational Helicopter Training Centre (MHTC) has taken over all the Helicopter Training Programmes' activities, namely the Helicopter Exercise Programme (HEP), the Helicopter Tactics Course (HTC) Programme and the Helicopter Tactics Instructors Course (HTIC) Programme from the **European Defence Agency (EDA) and on the** 1st of January 2024, the MHTC declared its Initial Operational Capability

# **MISSION**




The MHTC's mission is to improve European military helicopter interoperability and capability through a coordinated approach to training Tactics, Techniques and Procedures (TTPs) and doctrine. The aim is to improve and strengthen proficiency by delivering high-value multinational courses and exercises, harmonizing TTPs, and building up a European helicopter community, a top-level cadre of instructors, and a lessons learned repository.



# **ACTIVITIES** – annual "BLADE" exercise



The <u>"BLADE" exercise</u> is a 2–3-week exercise (EX) and is hosted by one of the MHTC Participants on a "rotational" base and is scheduled already for 10 years in advance (2026 is subject to change the location). During the exercise MHTC will support attendees with mentors (HTIs), provided by the MHTC Participants – <u>continuation of training</u>.

"Blade" exercise will provide an opportunity to train together using **common** helicopter Tactics, Techniques and Procedures (**TTP**) and to plan and execute complex missions in a multinational environment, in accordance with the **EDA/MHTC** Helicopter Exercise Programme (HEP) Standard Operating Procedures (**SOP**). The focus of this exercise is to enhance interoperability at the tactical level between rotary-wing as well as fixed-wing aviation units by using a COMposite Air Operations (**COMAO**) concept in a realistic and challenging joint and combined scenario, combining land and air operations.

# **ACTIVITIES** – Electronic Warfare (EW) course



The aim of the 2 weeks EW Course is to provide helicopter crews and support personnel with an in-depth look at EW theory and how it can be applied operationally. By the end of the course, trainees should have a thorough understanding of Radio Frequency (RF), Infra-Red (IR) and UltraViolet (UV) spectrum, Electro-Optical (EO), Low-Observable, Laser and Counter-Measure theory, as well as an understanding of how the Electro-Magnetic spectrum plays a part in operations and the manner in, which it can be exploited.

# ACTIVITIES - Electronic Warfare (EW) course - SIM



The 1<sup>st</sup> simulator-based EW "pilot course" was delivered in September 2024.

Based on the Lessons Learned (LL), a new course development has started by MHTC.

# **ACTIVITIES** – COMAO planning course



The aim of the 2 weeks COMAO Planning Course is to provide helicopter aircrew and support personnel with an in-depth look at the academics required for COMAO planning, a good understanding of complex rotary wing tactics and relevant experience in planning and briefing complex COMAO missions. By the end of the course, trainees should understand the roles required for COMAO planning, the "4Ts process" and the ability to deliver professional and well briefed products. Additionally, trainees will have an understanding of interoperability requirements and knowledge of the capabilities of a wide range of supporting and supported assets.

# Helicopter Tactics Course (HTC) – currently 6 times / year

### TRAIN THE TRAINER - ENSURES INTEROPERABILITY AND STANDARDIZATION

1st year

- BRONZE course graduate or "TACTICS TRAINEE"
- learn to adapt to new skills with the vehicle of "generic tactics" and fly tactically

2nd year

- SILVER tactics instructor or "HELICOPTER TACTICS INSTRUCTOR"
- learn to instruct generic tactics on ground, in the simulator and in the helicopter instructs
   Bronze student

3rd year


- GOLD tactics Instructor or "TRAIN THE TRAINER"
- successfully mentored trainee during international course

4th year

- Staff instructor
- can be recommended to join Blade Ex mentor team or return as staff instructor proven and self-propelled staff supporting on all levels







# **New MHTC Building + Simulator Hall**


- Preliminary Design concluded:
