## Main Responsibilities

Command Maritime Air Assets under NATO OPCON

Coordinate all Maritime Air activities related to NATO within the Maritime Domain

Plan, direct and convey MARCOM's Maritime (Air) Campaign Plan into AIRCOM's ATO/ACO

Coordinate Maritime Strike activities in close coordination with the JFCs, SFN, AIRCOM and the nations

Coordinate and de-conflict Maritime Air assets operating under national C2 throughout the NATO AOR

Coordinate and facilitate the Domain "SPACE" in MARCOM in close cooperation with AIRCOM

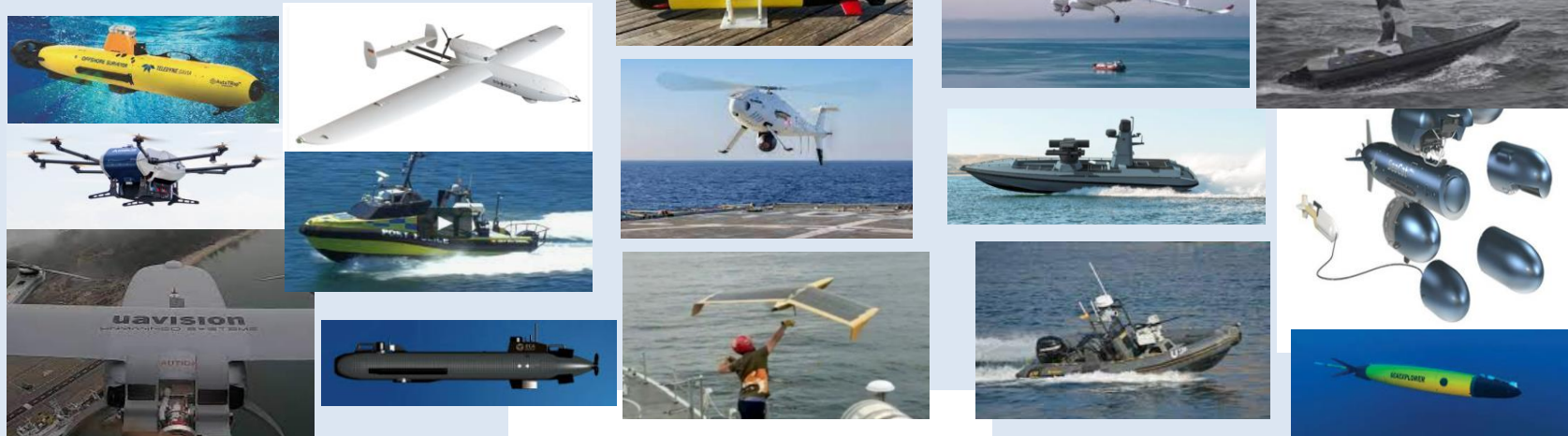

- **Industry sponsored to attend by a participating nation.**

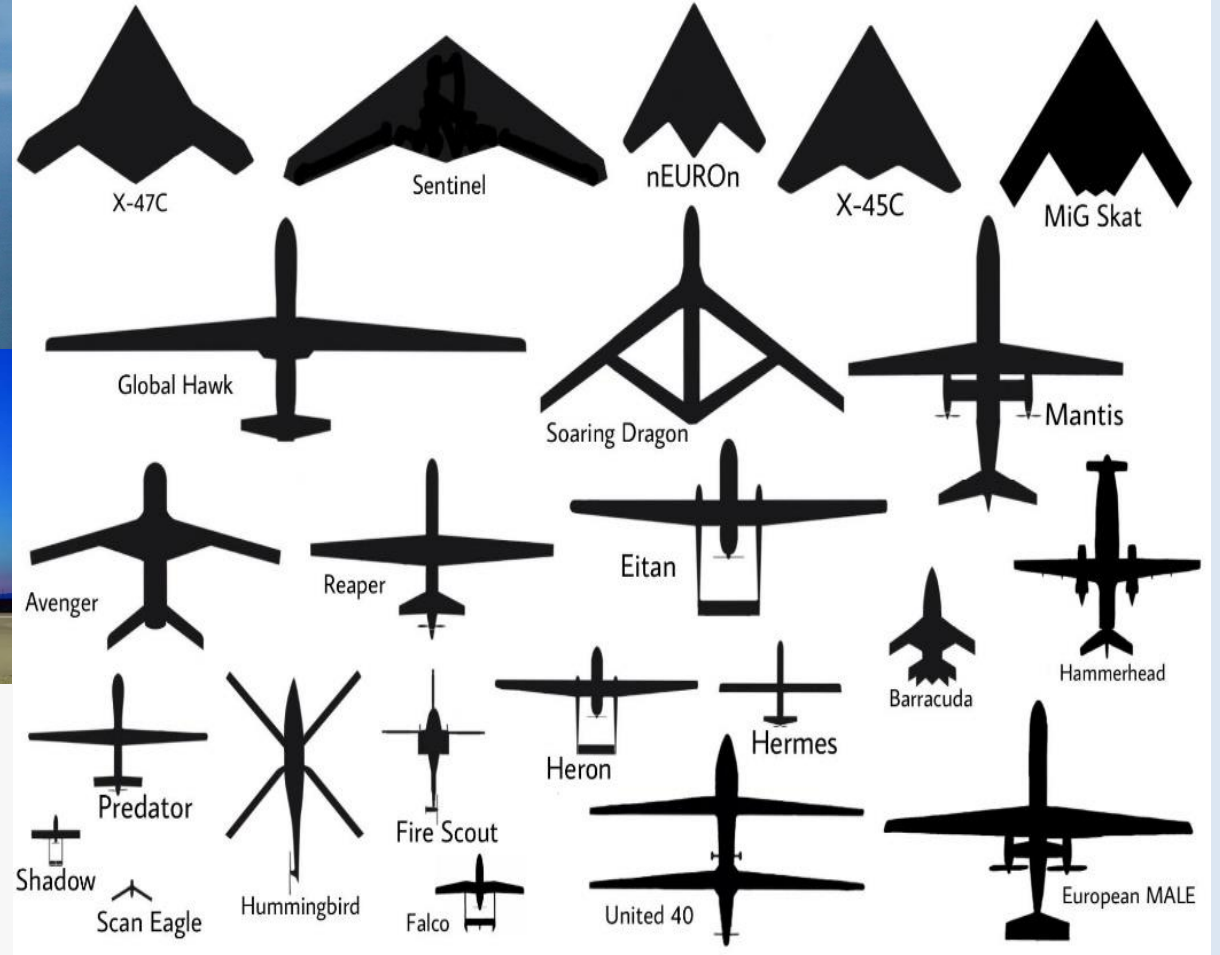

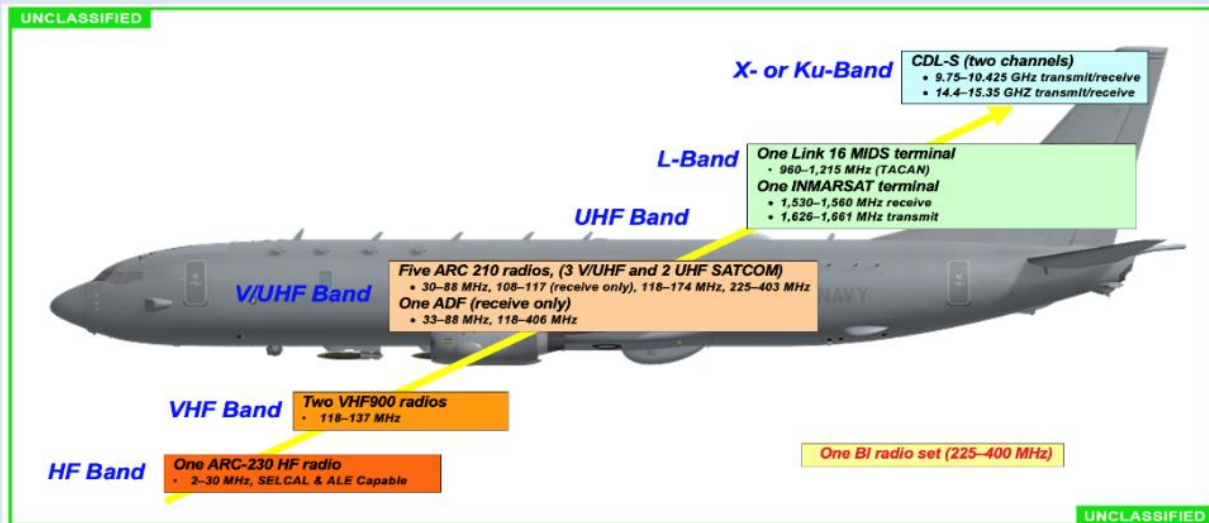
