### 3 METHODS

## 1. SURFACE ABANDONMENT

Primary method (If available)

**Urgent or Normal** 

Alertment by any means

Potential for 110-170 personnel in water

Wide range of casualties and complications

# 2. RESCUE BY SUBMERSIBLE

Preferred DISSUB option

7 days of life saving stores on board (variables)

Pod Posting can deliver extend time onboard

Alertment relies on SSE and air systems availability







## 3. TOWER ESCAPES

Last resort

Can take a long time from start to finish

2 escape compartments could have different outcomes

Higher risk of DCI

Potential of leaving injured personnel onboard







200M transit (60-70 seconds)
